

Town of Westmoreland Board of Selectmen

In response to COVID-19 Federal and State declarations of emergency and in an effort to protect Town personnel and citizens the Board of Selectmen have enacted the following interim measures.

- Westmoreland Town Offices will be closed to the public through May 31, 2020.
- Town personnel will be available by phone and/or email to answer questions or to set up any necessary appointments.
- All Town meetings, excluding the Board of Selectmen, are suspended through May 31, 2020.
- The Board of Selectmen recommends and encourages all people to use the online options for registrations with the Town Clerk's office.
- The Board of Selectmen, Town Clerk, and Tax Collectors offices will be open revised hours. Please call to determine if an in-person meeting is required. Please see Town Clerk and Tax Collector pages for more information.
- There will be no functions held at Town Hall until after May 31, 2020. Any fees already paid will be refunded.
- The Recycling Center will be open as regularly scheduled (No large items or construction debris will be accepted)
Stickers cannot be purchased at Recycling Center
- The Highway Department will continue normal operations.
