# Minutes of the Westmoreland Selectmen's Meeting Thursday, September 19, 2019

## **BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT**: Russ Austin, Frank Reeder, Clayton Stalker

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:00PM by Chairman Russ Austin.
- 2. Approval of Minutes: September 19, 2019 Motion was made by Clayton Stalker, second by Russ Austin to accept the minutes as printed. Motion passed 3-0.

#### 3. Guests:

Fire Chief Harry Nelson was present to inform the Selectmen that the grant for the thermal imaging cameras for the fire department has been approved.

Harry informed the Selectmen about a call the department had at a business in the Industrial Park. He stated that it would be helpful if he knew what businesses were located in the Park, contact and alarm system information and what materials are being used, stored, etc. This information would make going to calls safe for all concerned.

Forms will be developed to obtain current information and to keep the town informed of business changes.

4. Accounts Payable: A motion was made by Frank Reeder, second by Clayton Stalker to approve a manifest of \$4,980.11 for the highway department and \$11,941.34 for all other bills for a total of \$16,921.45. Motion passed 3-0.

- B. The Selectmen discussed the hiring of a Project Manager for the construction phase of the proposed Fire Station. They would like someone with municipal experience to oversee the town's interest in the process. Several names have been obtained to look at. A description of what the work will entail will be done.
- C. The fabric building at the highway garage is scheduled to be installed October 7<sup>th</sup>.
