WESTMORELAND CONSERVATION COMMISSION <u>UNAPPROVED MINUTES</u>

Meeting called to order by Chairman Perry Sawyer at 7:15PM.

Motion passed. Perry will contact the Selectmen.

Peter Throop from the Monadnock Conservancy was recognized and discussed in detail the 48 acre parcel of land in Westmoreland (tax parcel R16-48) that the Conservancy is purchasing to put it into a Conservation Easement. The total project budget is \$343,000.00. Peter requested \$5000.00 from the Westmoreland Conservation Commission's Conservation Fund to help cover transaction costs.

Perry made a motion to recommend to the Selectmen a withdrawal of \$5000.00 be made from the WCC Conservation Fund to assist with this project. Alisha seconded.

Motion made by Alish second by Stuart to accept unapproved minutes from 07-11-2024 without corrections. All in favor.

Old Home Day booth to be located on the Town Common on August 17. April will put information for the booth together next week and set it up on the 17th.

Perry reported that all final building reports for the new fire station are currently housed in the station and available to be seen.

Perry spoke with Selectmen regarding the SWRP culvert study. John Snowdon assured Perry that the final information would be passed to the Conservation Commission upon completion which will take about another year.

There was no new business.

April made a motion to adjourn, Alisha seconded. Meeting adjourned at 9:35PM.
