1. The meeting was called to order at 6pm by Rose Marie Semanski
2. Jon Lounsbury, Andy Mackey & TJ Kelly will be organizing the parade. Permit is up to date. Selectmen will help with traffic control. 5. Craft vendors will be donating gifts to be raffled. Theresa will oversee the raffle.
6. Rose solicited well over \$1000 worth of prizes to be divided between games, contests, vendor raffle and the car event raffle
7. Jon Lounsbury will oversee the Frog and Pie eating contests. Laina Scanlan will oversee the cupcake walk. TJ Kelly will host Trivia.
8. Friday a 20x30 tent will be set up on the common and remaining set up will take place. Mickey Russel and Alan Richardson have volunteered to help set up the car event and miscellaneous signs. Dave Poklemba will post no parking signs along the cemetery.
9. The water slide and foam frenzy need water. Also need 2 separate outlets for bounce houses. Jodi to contact Mark Hayward.
10. Music on the common - Nate Paine will play during vendor time and Gazebo Boys will play 4-7. There will be seating under the tent for BBQ if people choose to stay, eat and listen to music.
