Minutes from The Recycling Committee (draft)

Meeting called to order at 4:10 pm. No quorum again this week.

Ronnie Fish has given his resignation notice to the BOS. Evelyn has stepped in to help keep the RC open along with Bob Davis. Bill and Harry will work together to decide when the containers need to be hauled.

It was decided that the Committee will post some information on the Westmoreland Facebook site with no comments but have a link to the town's website.

As we plan for 2026, we want to show the amount of savings from the Recycle Center. There is a small group working on a spread sheet to show the monetary savings.

- We need to keep track of exactly how many residents are using the RC. Could this be done with stickers or a tally count?
- Would there be any savings if the RC were open from 8:00 to 3:45? Split shifts on Saturdays?

Bill and Harry are looking for another local store or two who would sell Westmoreland trash bags. They have some corporate offices to contact. We also talked about selling bags at the RC with checks only. Calls have been made to WasteZero to see where we stand on bag quantities.

Signs will be made to indicate which containers go to the landfill and which go for recycling. As well as the cost of hauling and tipping the bin and the savings on the recycle bins.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:00pm.
