

On July 19<sup>th</sup>, we invite you to help us commemorate the <u>100th anniversary of the</u> <u>Scopes (Monkey) Trial</u>, where a school teacher was convicted in 1925 of the "crime" of teaching his students about Darwin's explanation for the origin of humankind. That guilty verdict severely impacted how biology was taught for many decades afterwards. The trial was depicted in the classic movie "<u>Inherit The Wind</u>", which is well worth watching, or rewatching if it's been a while since you saw it.



Professor Alan Rogers, who taught anthropology at the University of Utah and who literally wrote the book on "The Evidence For Evolution", (available on Amazon) will give a presentation about the evidence for and against evolution that was known during Darwin's time, and then contrast that with evidence available today.
