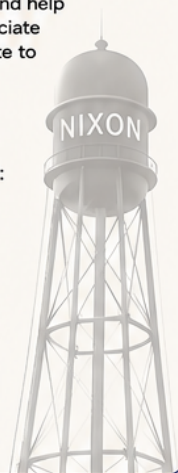
I am committed to listening, learning and leading with both heart and purpose. By working together as a team, we can make smart decisions and build a stronger, brighter future for our city.

FROM THE COUNCIL TABLE

New Parking Ordinance Approved

City Council approved Ordinance No. O-2026-08-17. This ordinance prohibits parking, sitting or standing vehicles in city-maintained alleys and alleyway or of other unauthorized locations. It also addresses permanent vehicle parking in front and side yards. Vehicles must be parked in a designated driveway or other authorized parking area. A brief summary is provided on the City of Nixon website. Residents without internet access may stop by City Hall to request a copy.



Budget & Tax Rate

City Council approved the proposed 2026–27 fiscal year budget, and the City's 2026–27 tax rate was proposed at the August meeting. The budget and tax rate are scheduled for final adoption at the September meeting.
