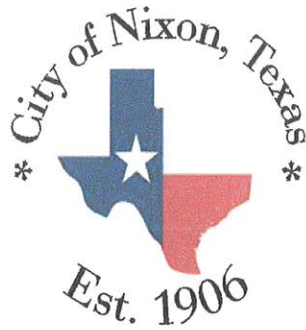




Notice of Meeting
