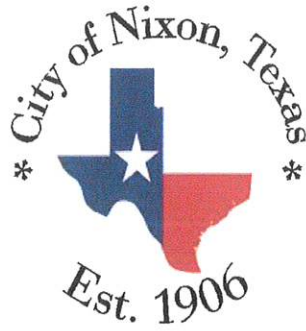




Notice of Meeting

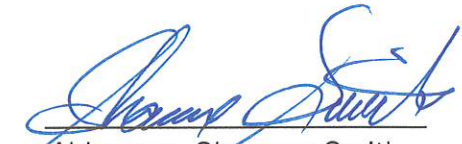
