WHO WE ARE

Third Sector International (3Si) is a vocational training and research centre based in Seville, dedicated to promoting the social, economic and cultural integration of young people across Europe. We have over eight years of experience in community engagement and our work seeks to improve employability, develop social networks and promote cultural integration. Primarily we work to support youth employment within the community and aim to help people develop the kind of skills and experience needed to find future employment in an increasingly demanding and international labour market.

3Si works with a range of partners to carry out its activities, including over 200 employers in Andalusia, training organisations around Europe and colleges in both the UK and Spain. The vocational work placements arranged and supervised by 3Si are supported by funding available from Erasmus Plus and for apprenticeships, such as CDF. Our experience, employer network and dedication has resulted in thousands of successful placements over the years, with many students going into further training or employment.

OUR PROJECTS

3Si offers fully supported vocational work placements to participants of the Erasmus Plus programme. We work with Further Education colleges and training centres to deliver projects in a range of sectors, including **Catering & Hospitality; Teaching; Digital Marketing; Creative Industries; Tourism; Construction; Ecology & Community Development; and Sports & Leisure.** We provide and manage placements that give participants the necessary work experience to complement their studies, build their confidence and explore a new cultural environment.

3Si also participates in research projects with partners from around Europe in the sector of vocational education and training. Our successfully completed projects include creating new European courses in Community Development, Creative Industries and Entrepreneurial Skills using the ECVET framework.





Students will have the opportunity to work alongside local organisations aiming to develop self-sufficient communities or advance research in conservation and ecology. The region of Andalusia offers a wonderful environment to develop a unique set of skills and understand community engagement. Working with people of different nationalities and backgrounds will be a great asset for a student looking to progress a career in this sector. Our partners in this programme work in a range of fields, from environmental justice and consumer rights to managing community centres for the disadvantaged.

Our main partner in ecology and conservation, Doñana Biological Station (EBD), is a prominent public research institute linked to one of the most important natural protected areas in Europe, Doñana National Park. Their mission is to conduct multidisciplinary research aimed at better understanding how biodiversity is generated, maintained and damaged. EBD also investigates the consequences of its loss and the chances of its preservation and restoration. Communicating their research to the public and engaging with various stakeholders is a vital part of the organisation. Students will have the opportunity to assist researchers and specialists in a variety of scientific and conservation projects.
