An Update on Our Current Relocation Plan:

As we print and post the news, it is almost immediately "Old News" by the time it gets to you. That is just how fast this train is moving, so we apologize, but here we are TODAY, June 24, 2023...

We have developed a 3-phase plan.

Phase One:

Secure a property that will act as a temporary location to allow us to open and become operational at a some limited capacity.

This property will not be ideal or what is required to continue operating at the same level as in the past, but it will allow us to help our community and injured wildlife at some level.

Phase Two:

Secure (purchase) property. This property will ultimately become the new "Forever Home" of WRCNU.

Phase Three:

Capital Campaign. In order to build the facility that will allow us to operate to our full potential we will need to secure major funds to build an animal rehabilitation facility with an education "wing".

Where are we right now?

We have located our temporary property and should be signing for it and the loan this coming week.

Once we take possession of the property there will still be a couple items left before we can begin the cleanup and preparation part to ready the building for use. Right now, we are waiting for approval from the Ogden City Planning with the typical back and forth to nail everything down. We must have this in order to obtain a business license from the City for this location.

While slow and agonizing, everything is moving forward and we anticipate that this will be our new temporary home for approximately 5 years while we are moving on with our next phases.

The property that we are investing in will eventually be resold and reinvested into our forever home.
