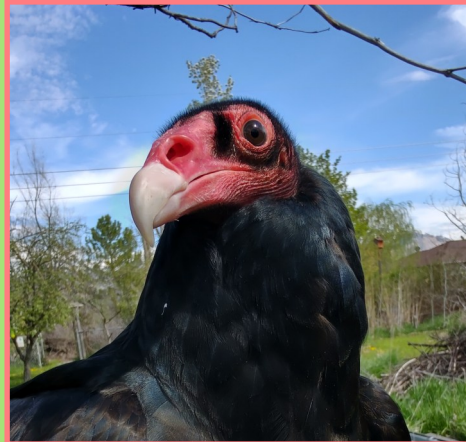




Far left, volunteer and board member releases an American White Pelican after several months healing and fattening up. Center left "he" happily swims away.
