



Parent Code of Conduct

Prairie Fire Volleyball Club is a volunteer-run, not-for-profit organization committed to creating a positive, respectful, and safe environment where athletes can grow both on and off the court. Parents and guardians play a critical role in supporting the physical, social, and emotional development of our athletes.

Our club operates through the dedication of volunteer coaches, board members, families, sponsors, and community supporters. To help keep club fees as affordable as possible for all families, Prairie Fire Volleyball Club relies heavily on parent involvement, fundraising efforts, and sponsorship initiatives throughout the season.

As a parent/guardian of a Prairie Fire Volleyball Club athlete, I agree to the following:

1. I will remember that youth sports are for the athletes to learn, grow, compete, and have fun.
2. I will model positive behavior and treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with respect and courtesy at all times.
3. I will not engage in unsportsmanlike behavior, including taunting, arguing, profanity, threatening behavior, or inappropriate gestures.
4. I will not encourage or participate in any behavior that could endanger the safety or well-being of any athlete, coach, official, or spectator.
5. I will encourage my child to play by the rules, show good sportsmanship, and resolve conflicts respectfully.
6. I will focus on effort, development, teamwork, and improvement rather than winning alone.
7. I will respect coaches and officials and will not confront them during games, tournaments, or practices. I will follow the 24-hour rule before discussing concerns related to coaching decisions or playing time.
8. I will not coach athletes from the sidelines unless I am an official member of the coaching staff.
9. I will encourage my child to communicate directly with coaches regarding questions or concerns about their development or role on the team.
10. I understand that failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action for myself and/or my child, including reduced playing time, suspension from team activities, or removal from Prairie Fire Volleyball Club events.
11. I understand Prairie Fire Volleyball Club is a volunteer-run, not-for-profit organization that depends on fundraising, sponsorship, and volunteer support to operate successfully and keep fees affordable for families. I agree to actively support and participate in club fundraising, sponsorship, volunteer, and team initiatives throughout the season to the best of my ability.

Prairie Fire Volleyball Club has zero tolerance for abusive, threatening, or disrespectful behavior. Our goal is to provide every athlete with a positive experience built on respect, accountability, teamwork, and community support.
