

For the Brownies

- l cup creamy peanut butter
- 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 2 cups brown sugar
- 3 eggs, beaten
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup Reese's Pieces candies

For the Frosting

- 2 cups creamy peanut butter
- 1 cup butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 4 tablespoons heavy whipping cream
- 2 cups powdered sugar

For the Brownies

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. In a large bowl, blend together the peanut butter and butter.
- 3. Beat in brown sugar, eggs and vanilla.
- 4. Add flour and salt.
- 5. Spread into a greased 13×9 inch baking pan.
- 6. Bake for 30-35 minutes.
