We further promise to consistently remember one another in prayer, to graciously aid one another in hardships and distress, to be slow to anger, quick to forgive, and always be a willing agent of reconciliation wherever it is needed.

Finally, we promise that if we move from this place we will as soon as possible unite with another church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's word.
