## Premise:

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A woman finds herself in the middle of a global invasion with nothing but the clothes on her back and an unwelcome alliance with someone she swore to forget.

## Character Notes:

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**Female main character:** Lana, 32, bartender, long black hair, poor survival skills, social

**Male main character:** Eli, 35, mechanic, buzzed hair, great survival skills, loner

- They had a one-night stand in college (over a decade ago) but the morning after there was a big miscommunication that turned into a massive fight. Though they still have mutual friends to this day, they harbor ill will toward the other and do not speak or hang out. Though, of course, that angst is only self-preservation for the feelings they've harbored all this time.

## Worldbuilding:

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- Takes places in Nashville, TN and the surrounding rural areas
- After the initial attack, the power grid goes down; it's chaos and every man for themselves
- The extraterrestrials are ghastly beasts that stand twelve feet tall on four limbs; they can't communicate with humans; they came out of the flaming projectiles that cracked open upon impact with the Earth's surface; no one knows where they came from or who sent them; they hunt in packs

## Notes:

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Though this is a horror novel, there is a romance subplot that provides some light-hearted moments amidst all of the destruction, violence, and danger. As Lana and Eli struggle to survive together, they rekindle old feelings and learn that they're stronger together.

**POV:** Lana

**Objective:** introduce the reader to the world, set the stakes

**Plot overview:** Lana is in line at the grocery store. It's early evening (after 4pm). She's trying to get her grocery shopping done before she has to head into the bar later. She's still tired from last night's shift and all she wants to do is hurry home to make a quick bite to eat and shower before work. The grocery store is packed and she's impatient. The atmosphere in the line around her is much of the same. The man behind Lana is talking on the phone loudly, seemingly arguing with someone about work deadlines. The mother in front of her is balancing her toddler on one hip while arranging all of her items on the conveyor belt. The checker is a bored-looking teenage boy with bangs that hang in front of his eyes and a dangly silver earring. Everything seems normal and almost banal. Just as one customer leaves and the mother with the toddler steps up to the checkout, there's a shuddering roar and, through the window-lined storefront, Lana spots a massive flame of hurtling fire before it strikes the parking lot with a booming crash. **POV:** Eli

**Objective:** build tension, further press the inciting incident

**Plot overview:** A man swerves on the highway, steering his motorcycle out of the way as the two cars in front of him slam into each other. The man (Eli) watches as another of those flaming projectiles descend from the sky and crash into the overhead freeway ramp. He continues to dodge and weave around cars and debris as the chaos continues to rain down on him. He cracks the throttle and tears down an exit ramp. There's just as much destruction and chaos off the highway. There are car alarms, sirens, and screaming everywhere. Though it's softly muffled, he can still hear it all through his helmet. He goes to take a right turn at an intersection but sees a firetruck barreling through.
