Heaven Is . . .

Introduction:

There are numerous passages referring to heaven. We sing about it "To Canaan's Land I'm On My Way". But what is heaven?

I) <u>Three Ways The Word "Heaven" is Used In The Bible</u>

A) The earth's atmosphere. *Deut. 11.17, Acts 14.17*

- 1. Place where the clouds float and birds fly.
- 2. We understand this is not the heaven we desire to go to when we die.

B) Where the Sun, Moon, and Stars are, *Ps.* **19.4**

- 1. We can see the beauty of heaven when we look out at the moon and stars at night.
- 2. But we realize this is not the heaven we are looking to go to when we die.

C) The dwelling place of God, *Matthew 5.16*

- There are passages which speaks of this, *Psalms 11.4* "the Lord's throne is in heaven"
- 2. *Ps. 119.89* "Your word is settled in heaven"
- 3. This is the heaven we want to spend the rest of our lesson talking about.

II) <u>Heaven Is...</u>

A) The opposite of hell

- 1. Where Jesus talked about the pain and punishment of hell in *Matthew 25.30* and even *Mark 9.42-48*.
- 2. Jesus speaks about the good and joy of heaven. *Revelation 21.4*

B) The eternal home of the righteous

- 1. Home is the place we live, where we belong, a place of comfort and attachment.
- 2. The place those of faith desired to go, Abraham, *Hebrews 11.13-16*.
 - a. We sing "this world's not my home, I'm just a passing thru. My treasures are laid up somewhere beyond the blue... And I can't feel at home in this world anymore."
 - b. This world really isn't our home, *Ecc.* 12.5.
- 3. Fact: we are eternal beings living in physical bodies living in a temporary world.

C) Heaven is a prepared place for a prepared people, *John 14.1-3*

- 1. Prepared to make ready (to prepared a meal, to prepare a bedroom.
 - a. In this verse it refers to Jesus dying so we can have the right to be there.
 - b. To make available for us.
- 2. While Jesus did His part we must do our part.
- D) Heaven is a place of rest, *Hebrews 4.9-11*

- 1. Those who have worked out their salvation, been faithful in serving God will have a time of rest, *Revelation 14.13*.
- 2. Rest is this passage does not mean the same thing as inactivity.
- E) Heaven is a place of worship, *Revelation 4.8, 11;* 5.9-10, 12-14
 - 1. I have heard it said, "if you don't like or want to worship God now, what makes you think you will like heaven?"
- F) Heaven is a place of friends, of those of like faith, *Hebrews 12.22-24*
 - 1. We look forward to seeing our friends and love ones here.
 - 2. Everyone in heaven will be our friend, commonality in our desire to serve God.
- G) Heaven is a place of beauty, *Rev. 4.1-4*
 - 1. We often see things of beauty here, sunrise or sunset, landscape, flowers, etc. Such beauty is fading and eventually goes away.
 - 2. The beauty of heaven does not fade away or disappoint us.
 - 3. Bible writers gives us descriptive terms, mentioning things of great value streets of gold, pearly gates, etc.
- H) Heaven is a place of light

- 1. There will be no night there, no darkness, *1 John 1.5*.
- 2. God is light, *Rev. 21.22-27*
- 3. Place of purity and cleanness.
- I) Heaven is a place of joy, *Matthew* 25
 - 1. Past pain will be forgotten; all cares and sorrow will be gone. *Rev. 21.4*
 - 2. One day I was entering a restaurant that had a play area for the young children. As I was opening the door a lady came out with a crying child. He was crying "I don't want to go." I said to the momma, he is having too much fun to leave. That joy is what we will have in heaven.

Conclusion:

Remember God has a place for you and me. Jesus died to prepare that place, and it awaits our arrival. Do you want to go to such a place as heaven? If so then be prepared, make your preparations so you will be there.
