Divine Wisdom

The first assumption in determining any position religiously is: God is infinite in all His attributes. He is infinite in knowledge, infinite in wisdom, and infinite in His power. This means that God knows His own mind and knows man and man's needs. It means that He has the wisdom to provide perfectly for those needs as they contribute to the accomplishing of His divine purpose. Further, He has the power by which to bring to man the remedy for his needs, and through man to carry out His divine purpose to its triumphant end. Being infinite in these attributes God makes no mistakes, nor does He experiment. He knows the end from the beginning, and knows what He can do and how that which He wants done should be done.
