demanded. Blasphemy, violating the Sabbath, idolatry, adultery, etc were punished by stoning.

## III) Forgiveness

## A) Means to not hold something against, *Romans 4.7-8*

- It is what we desire when we had done something wrong.
- 2. We are told to seek forgiveness from our fellowman and God. *Matthew 5.23-24*
- 3. Justice demands the sinner die for their sins, *Romans* 6.23a.

## B) But forgiveness is hard to give, *Luke 17.3-4, 5*

- 1. There is a real cost associated with the offense.
- 2. They had personally harmed us, done something against us.
- 3. Just as our sins are against the very nature of God and there is a cost to our forgiveness.
- 4. That is why the example of Brandt Jean got so much attention.
  - The world says to seek vengeance and hold grudges.
  - b. The world even questioned the ulterior motives of this young man.

## C) Mercy

1. We want to escape the consequences of our sins.
