- B. Paul is apply this to Christians who have received this forgiveness, our greatest debt has been forgiven, image how you would feel if "extreme home makeover" came to your house and your loan was forgiven, our debt of sin is far greater hence its forgiveness is a reason for greater joy.
- C. We can face God with a good clean conscious.

- C. Behold to see, to observe, pay attention to
- D. God counts the Christian as one of His children, part of His household.
- E. Nothing can separate us from His love, *Romans* 8.35
 - 1. Does not mean we can not be lost.
 - 2. We can not say we are lost because God did not love us.

III. THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT CONTAINS JOY, GALATIANS 5.22

- A. I appreciate Christians that can laugh, have fun, and show they like being who they are.
- B. We are not at our best when we do not enjoy. The more joy the better we are at life.
- C. We do not convert people to be miserable.
- D. Have you ever asked somebody, "Why are you so happy?" Have you had somebody ask you?
 - 1. We went to a funeral and that was asked of us.
 - 2. Our children need to understand being a Christian does not mean your funny bone was removed at the point of baptism. (Kemuel and Sunshine)

IV. HAPPY TO KNOW I AM A MEMBER OF GOD'S FAMILY, JOHN 1.12

- A. We can turn to the Bible and show what we are and why. *Acts* 2.41,47

- 2. Parents that want their children to obey God must do so themselves. Etc, friends, classmates, other family
