Solomon's Prayer - 1 Kings 8:22-61 Sunday PM 10/27/19

I) Background

- A) Temple completed, 1 Kings 7.51
- B) Assembly of elders, heads of tribes, chief fathers of the children of Israel, 1 Kings 8.1a
- C) The Ark of the Covenant and the holy furnishings of the tabernacle brought into the temple, *v. 1b-ff*.
- D) Sacrifices made, v. 5.
- E) The Ark brought into the "Most Holy Place" v. 6
- F) The glory of the Lord filled the house of the Lord, *v.*

II) Solomon's Prayer

A) Setting

- Before the altar in the presence of all the people,
 v. 22a
- 2. Raises his hands toward heaven, Solomon was kneeling, *v. 54, Nehemiah 8.6*
- 3. Must be done with a humble heart. *James 4.10*, *Psalms 19.14*

B) Prayer is addressed towards God in heaven, *v.* 22b.

- 1. Who or what is God?
 - a. There is no other God like you, "God of Israel", *v. 23a*
 - b. How so? Solomon does not talk about God's eternal nature, or power, etc.

- 2. The God who keeps His covenant, *v.* 23*b*.
 - a. Covenant with David, 2 Samuel 7.13
 - b. Covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.
- 3. God too big for a temple, v. 27, Acts 17.24
 - a. As opposed to idols and their temples.
 - b. The gods only exist in their temples- Dagon, Molech, Baal, etc.

C) God who listens to prayer, v. 24-27

- 1. Hear in heaven, is the key to each thing in our list. God is in heaven.
- 2. Hear in heaven and forgive, v. 30
- 3. Hear in heaven and judge, *v.* 31-32
 - a. God condemns the wicked and upholds the righteous.
 - b. When Israel is defeated by their enemies, they need to turn back to God and ask for forgiveness.
- 4. Hear in heaven and restore, *v.* 33-34
- 5. Hear in heaven and send rain (blessings), *v.* 35-36.
- 6. Hear in heaven and teach them the good way to walk.
- 7. Hear in heaven and minister justice, *v.* 37-40
- 8. Hear in heaven the foreigner, *v.* 41-43
 - a. Those not in a covenant relationship with God.

- b. Think of Cornelius.
- 9. Hear in heaven and give victory, *v.* 44-45.
 - a. Going out to battle- physical battles
 - b. Spiritual battles, 2 Corinthians 10.4-5.
- 10. Hear in heaven, deliver and preserve, v. 46-53.
 - a. There is no one who does not sin, *v.* 46a.
 - b. Carried off to captivity, *v.* 46b-47.
 - c. When they return with their heart and soul, *v.* 48.
 - d. Have compassion on them.
 - e. For they are your people, *v.* 51-53.

III) Benediction/Preaching and Prayer

- A) Recognition of being blessed, v. 55-56
 - 1. All of God's promises had been kept, v. 56
 - 2. May God always be with them, v. 57
 - 3. May they keep His commandments, His statutes, His judgements, *v.* 58
- B) May God remember his prayer, v. 59a.
 - May He maintain the cause of His servant, His people, v. 59b.
 - 2. All the people of the earth know that the Lord is God. *V.* 60.
 - 3. They walk in His statues, His ways, *v.* 61.

Conclusion:

The high point of Solomon's life was when Solomon prayed recognizing God, His blessings, His word.
