# Some Things We Should <u>NOT</u> Say To Ourselves Sunday PM 05/19/19

#### Introduction:

Yogi Berra is credited with saying, "90% of baseball is mental, the other half is physical." Our mental attitude affects how we act and react. Bible places a great deal on what we think (*Phil. 4.8*). Jesus did not die on the cross so His disciples would have a defeatist attitude toward life, *1 John 5.4*.

- I) We should Not Tell Ourselves That We Are Worthless
  - A) Most self-destructive behavior is due to poor self-esteem.
    - 1. Self-mutilation, running down one's self, neglect of our bodies, etc.
    - 2. Some believe it is part of being a Christian, to feel bad about one self.
  - B) All of us was created by God, *Genesis 1.26-27* 
    - 1. Each of us was made in His image, *Psalm 139.14*
    - 2. Each of us possess unique abilities and talents.
    - 3. We are loved by God and people close to us. *John 3.16*

#### II) <u>I Can't Help Myself or The Devil Made Me Do It or God</u> <u>Made Me This Way</u>

A) All of us face temptations, *James 1.13-15,1 Corinthians 10.13a* 

- 1. Some may be stronger with some people than others but none of us are above temptation.
- 2. We might feel we are fighting a losing battle, *Romans 7.15, 18-20*

#### B) We can overcome sin, *Genesis* 4.7

- 1. Must take the way of escape, 1 Corinthians 10.13b.
- 2. Flee youthful lust, 2 *Timothy 2.22a*
- 3. Must always guard against whatever temptation we face but we can control ourselves with prayer, study, and help from others.

## III) I Have Been A Sinner Too Long To Change Now

#### A) Can't teach an old dog new tricks?

- 1. You are not a dog but a person, and old dogs can be taught new tricks!
- 2. Old habits can be hard to change but that does not make them unchangeable.

### B) You can change if you set your mind to it

- 1. How old were: Abram and Sarai (*Genesis 12.5;* 17.17), Noah (*Genesis 6.3; 7.6*), Moses (*Acts 7.23,30*)?
- 2. How old was the Ethiopian Eunuch? *Acts* 8
- 3. How old was Lydia or the Philippians Jailer in Acts 16?
- 4. One's age is not the determining factor. It is your willingness!

### IV) I Am Not Worse Than (Fill in the Blank)

# A) This emphasizes the wrong standard, 2 Corinthians 10.12

- 1. You can always find someone better or worse than you.
- 2. A false standard will bring about a bad result.

### B) The standard is God's word, *John 12.48-49*

- 1. We all fail in comparison with Jesus but He is our example, *1 Peter 2.21*
- 2. My job is to be the best Christian I can be, regardless of what anyone else is or isn't doing.

# V) It Is Not My Business to Spread the Gospel

# A) Some believe the Great Commission does not exist today or does not apply to me.

- 1. Let someone else do it, talk to a neighbor, invite someone to church, etc.
- 2. Most of us are uncomfortable talking about religion to God so we pass it on to someone else.

### B) The Great Commission Applies to the Disciples, Mark 16.15; Luke 24; Matthew 28.

- 1. Paul told Timothy to teach men and then have then to teach others, 2 *Timothy 2.2*
- 2. Christ taught during His ministry and we are followers of Christ.
- 3. Can we go to heaven by ourselves?

# VI) <u>I Will Go To Hell Because God Will not Save Me</u>

# A) Some blame God for being lost or being in a sinful situation.

- 1. Recent candidate for President, is an open homosexual in a homosexual marriage. When questioned about it, he said God made him this way.
- 2. Does God make us drunkards, adulterers, thieves, etc. This goes back to an earlier point God does not make us sin, we choose to do so.

#### B) Jesus died so we can go to heaven, *John 1.12*

- 1. Our sins are washed away by His blood, read *Ephesians 1.7 and 2.1ff*.
- 2. The people at Corinth could go to heaven, *1 Corinthians 6.9-11*.
- 3. If we are lost is it because we choose to be lost, 2 *Thess. 1.8*
