We want to look at the history of "Pride Month", The Rainbow and what it represents to the homosexual movement, the Supreme Court's impact with it 2015 ruling, and what the Bible says about all of this.

I) Pride Month and the Rainbow

A) Pride Month

- LGBT Pride Month occurs in the United States to commemorate the Stonewall riots, which occurred at the end of June 1969. As a result, many pride events are held during this month to recognize the impact LGBT people have had in the world. Three presidents of the United States have officially declared a pride month. B) The Rainbow and homosexuality

1. The **rainbow** flag was popularized as a symbol of the gay community by San Francisco artist Gilbert Baker in 1978. The different colors are often associated with "diversity" in the gay community (but actually

- have literal meanings).
- 2. In the original eight-**color** version, pink stood for sexuality, red for life, orange for healing, **yellow** for the sun, green for nature, turquoise for art, indigo for harmony and violet for the soul.
- 3. Pride flag is based on the rainbow colors.
- II) Supreme Court Ruling on Homosexual Marriages.
 - A) Jun 26, 2015 In a long-sought victory for the gay rights movement, the court ruled, 5-4, that the Constitution guarantees a right to same-sex marriage.
 - 1. "No longer may this liberty be denied," Justice Anthony M. Kennedy wrote for the majority in the historic decision.
 - 2. "If you are among the many Americans of whatever sexual orientation who favor expanding same-sex marriage, by all means celebrate today's decision," Chief Justice Roberts wrote. "Celebrate the achievement of a desired goal. Celebrate the opportunity for a new expression of commitment to a partner. Celebrate the availability of new benefits. But do not celebrate the Constitution. It had nothing to do with it."

B) After math
