AIM-TN announces that the implementation of its pilot Siemens STEM DAY program in conjunction with Siemens, Metro Nashville Public Schools (MNPS) and other corporate volunteers is realizing tremendous success. Through this program, AIM-TN facilitates the delivery of Siemens STEM DAY activities (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) to Middle school kids within MNPS. AIM-TN initiated this program on November 20, 2019 and in just three months is seeing positive results.

Through February 28, 2020, the data shows:

- Forty-five separate MNPS classes participated in a Siemens STEM DAY exercise
- Sixteen schools participated
- Approximately 1300 students were mentored
- Thirteen different Siemens STEM DAY exercises were selected by schools and presented
- Nearly 600 hours of volunteer work was donated through AIM-TN's volunteer network

AIM-TN is planning to expand this initiative, incorporating additional STEM DAY exercises and schools. Also, because of the initial STEM DAY success, there are tremendous growth opportunities that can positively impact kids and families through other areas. Deploying Siemens STEM Day Activities also provides AIM-TN the opportunity to strengthen and expand other community building programs within their Career Readiness and Health & Wellness Pillars.
