## **Event Barn/Party Policies**

Thank you for allowing us to host your event! Please note the following policies as per our insurance coverage and liability limits. We are a small home farm - we live here and our farm animals are our pets - but we do love to share our big sky view and loving animals with others. When we first moved here I was obsessed with the wide open pasture and view of the sky and sunsets.

- 1. Capacity is limited by our insurance coverage to no more than 50
- 2. Our insurance prohibits alcohol consumption
- 3. I love dogs but please do not bring pets of any kind (they are a threat to the farm animals).
- 4. NO SMOKING at all of any kind; anywhere on the property
- 5. Closed toed shoes must be worn by each person on the property
- 6. \$200 deposit is required to hold your date and is non-refundable; the balance is due 48 hours prior to the event.
- 7. You are welcome to decorate the barn and bring food; please remove all decorations and debris; I'll provide trash bags and you can leave them here.
- 8. Farms attract flies. Plan on keeping food inside the event barn and covered. We tell them they aren't invited, but they show up anyway.
- 9. Your block of time is all yours to decorate, entertain, and clean up.
- 10. Rain/Weather I will work with you to the best of my ability. We have canopies and tents that make most weather tolerable; we will reschedule as best we can if the weather is an issue.
- 11. Cancellation Policy your deposit is non-refundable but I will do my best to reschedule and work with you; in the event of weather that is intolerable I will either refund or reschedule. No shows will not be refunded any amount.

# I will provide:

- The 16' x 18' event barn with heat or AC as necessary
- Trash receptacles
- Our camper for use of the bathroom and its a great decompression zone
- Hand sanitizer and/or portable sink
- A variety of tables and folding chairs (will provide table sizes for covers)
- 3 picnic tables with umbrellas (each seats 6)
- Some lawn games cornhole, hoppity hops and others

### **RATES**

Our vision is to keep the parties relatively **unstructured** so you can enjoy your day your way; that said, we do have some add-ons or options if you'd like more structure for your event. We have noticed that many children REALLY enjoy just running around and chasing each other through the pasture. We want to focus on the immersive experience of being on a farm, outside in the fresh air, away from electronics and screens. We are hoping to replicate old school fun - outside and just kids being kids.

Each event includes your use of the middle paddock so you have cows on the left side and goats on the right. We will delineate parking for safety of all involved. Use of the event barn, tables, chairs, gravel patio, and camper along with approximately an hour of owner led interaction with the animals. We then release the 7 Nigerian Dwarf goats into the paddock with you (if you want) to hang out and play.

The rest of the time is yours to enjoy! We will clean up all manure in advance, but keep in mind, animals poop and we may miss some. The hours below include your set up and break down time. Plan your guest arrival accordingly.

## Sugar Cookie Decorating Classes -

\$25/person (limit 12)

Farmgirl Cookies (me) will teach a sugar cookie decorating class that includes 4 cookies plus supplies and instructions. Approx. 60 minutes but requires the use of the event barn - so we'd have to discuss timing and set up. Not available in July/August as it's way too hot and humid for sugar cookies. Ages 8 and up.

### **Build your Own Cupcake**

\$5/person

Homemade cupcakes/brownies with a large variety of toppings, including such items as icing, whipped cream, pudding, cookies, sprinkles, chocolate and pb chips - etc. Each party will vary regarding which toppings are available.

### **DONE FOR YOU KIDS PARTY - \$500**

I get it! Sometimes all you can manage is scheduling the event, so here is our version of a "done for you" kids party:

- 2 hours from start to finish (times below are approximate)
- Event will be held in our little event barn
- 45 minute owner led meet & greet and learning about the animals
- 15 minutes to wash up; use the bathroom and get seated
- 15 minutes story time with age appropriate book (up to about 6 years)
- Cupcake bar or individual cupcake DIY stations each child will receive a cupcake and a variety of toppings with which to decorate it.
- Gift exchange
- Play time in the pasture games and hoppity hops (dating myself here!)

I provide everything including tables, chairs, table coverings, minimal decorations (barn doesn't really need them), set up, and clean up, and treats for the animals. I will be with you the entire time. MAXIMUM CAPACITY IS 15 CHILDREN - at least 2 adults must stay.

#### SUGAR COOKIE DECORATING CLASS PARTY

This is essentially the same sugar cookie decorating classes that I sell tickets for. I will provide 6 cookies with 4 icings and toppings as well as a powerpoint presentation and all of the tools and instructions required to complete the set. I have about 15 sets to choose from and we can do that together. The class is 90 minutes and we will add about 45 minutes for cake/gifts and a meet & greet with the animals. These classes are limited to 12 participants and are best suited for ages 10 and up. At least one adult must stay on the property. **Cost is \$55/person.**
