

2022 NCSSAA COLLEGIATE INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

NCSSAA invites you to participate in the first Collegiate International Championship, in partnership with Hillsdale College and USA Shooting.

LOCATION

COURSE OF FIRE

International Trap - 125 targets
International Skeet - 125 targets

This event will follow all USA Shooting rules and regulations.





SCHEDULE

Below is the competition schedule. International Skeet and Trap will run concurrently and competition will start at approximately 9 a.m. each day.

Friday, September 16 – Pre-Event Training (PET), 75 targets Saturday, September 17 – 75 targets Sunday, September 18 – 50 targets and finals

Please note, there is a **mandatory** competitor meeting at 8 a.m. on Saturday, September 17. Attendees at the PET are not required to shoot the full 75 targets and additional practice will be available in the days leading up to the match.

ENTRY

Registration is \$125 per athlete. Lunch will be available on-site, but is not included in the registration fee. Due to limited range capacity, this event is first-come, first-served for a maximum of 200 spots between International Skeet and Trap. Please note that athletes can register for only one event and *cannot* shoot both International Skeet and Trap.

As a USA Shooting sanctioned match, all competitors are required to be members of USA Shooting. Membership fees are \$30 for Juniors (20 and younger) or \$40 for Adults. Please process your membership online at https://members.usashooting.org/ prior to the competition.

ELIGIBILITY

NCSSAA eligibility requirements apply:

- Must have a cumulative 2.3 GPA. First-semester undergraduate students must have graduated high school with a cumulative 2.0 GPA.
- Must be in good standing with their university and team.
- Must be actively enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours for undergraduate students, and 6 credit
 hours for graduate students. Exceptions will be made for graduating seniors at Division I IV schools
 that are taking less than 12 credit hours to complete their degree and for students at Division V schools
 that have policies in place that prevent students from being enrolled in 12 credit hours. In these cases,

documentation must be provided to NCSSAA and the exception must be approved prior to competition.

- All athletes are limited to 10 semesters (or 15 quarters) of eligibility.
- Participants that graduated prior to Nationals but within the same academic year may still compete, assuming all other eligibility requirements were met upon graduation.

Verification of eligibility will be required upon registration.

RULES

All USA Shooting rules will be observed at this match, including but not limited to:

- 24g ammunition required
 - Winchester AA available for purchase on-site
- Approved line for International Skeet
- Clothing must follow USA Shooting guidelines

SQUADDING

Athletes will be randomly squadded. It's the athlete's responsibility to know their competition field and time. Please note that shooters will have scoring duties when not actively competing.

TROPHIES

Team and individual trophies will be awarded at the end of the competition.

Individual: The top three men and women will be awarded in each event. An HOA score is not applicable, as participants are unable to compete in both events.

Team: The top three teams in each event will be awarded. A team score is determined by the top three scores from each institution.

LODGING AND TRAVEL

Detroit (DTW) is the largest airport in the area. However, competitors can also fly into Grand Rapids (GRR) or Lansing (LAN).

Limited rooms are available at Hillsdale College's <u>Dow Center</u>, as well as RV hook-ups on-site. Additional lodging is available in Hillsdale, Coldwater, and Jackson.
