

NCSSAA DIVISION V WOMEN'S TRAP RANKINGS

The following page(s) outline the rankings for female athletes of NCSSAA Division V teams that have competed in any NCSSAA event during the 2022-2023 season (this includes sanctioned events). The requirements/determination of rankings are as follows:

- The competitor must belong to an NCSSAA member team.
- The ranking score will be determined as follows:
 - o The average of the **two** highest scores, with one coming from a regional event.
 - If the competitor has not shot at a regional, sanctioned scores will be used (this
 is **not** the case for qualification).
 - If a competitor has only shot one event, whether sanctioned or regional, the single score will be used as their ranking score.
- Rankings will be updated after each regional and sanctioned event.

Please note that rankings **have no impact on qualification scores.** A competitor may have a different ranking score than their qualifying score, but **only** the qualifying score will determine their ability to qualify and compete at Nationals.
