Private Space Feels Safe

Cats are solitary by nature and value their own territory. A private suite gives your cat a secure base where they can retreat, rest and feel in control. Having their own space reduces stress and supports confidence, especially in a new environment.

Designed for Natural Cat Behaviour

Our suites are multi-level with perches, hiding places, scratching surfaces and visual cover. This allows your cat to climb, observe, hide and watch their surroundings—behaviours that help them feel secure and comfortable in an unfamiliar environment.

Choice and Control Reduce Stress

Being able to choose where to rest, when to interact and when to hide gives cats a sense of control. Evidence shows that choice and predictability are key factors in helping cats cope with change and maintain wellbeing.
