Dear Matt,

Thank you for your letter, your points are noted. The decision to hold a series of smaller information sessions is a response to the current health and safety risks related to COVID. Unfortunately this is out of our control and although a single event would be easier logistically, we are of the view that it would not be responsible to host a larger public gathering as you describe in Ravenshoe at this time.

After evaluation of the current circumstances, we decided to proceed with multiple smaller briefings rather than reschedule because we appreciate that it is also important for community members to have an opportunity to speak directly with the project team as soon as possible. The sessions will give community members an opportunity to speak with the project team, learn more about the project, ask questions and share their concerns. They are open to anyone however as advised numbers for each are limited as density limits apply.

We do hope that you will attend a session so that our team can listen to your concerns and address any questions you may have. Please advise if you would like to attend, and which time would best suit so that we can allocate a place for you.

We will of course revert to holding public information sessions at a later, more appropriate time.
