


Spaghetti Diagram: Pharmacist

 Visual representation of an employee or product movement through an area






Walking Distance Reduction




New Kanban Inventory Control

Kanban Instructions

1) When supplies in a bin hit the reorder point, pull the Kanban card.

Full Bin: Pull from the side that is not covered with foam board

Reorder Point: When one side is empty and you reach the side covered with foam board lower the cover, remove the Kanban card and use the remaining supplies.

Kanban Instructions

- 2) Place removed Kanban card in the mailbox Kanban Card Mailbox. There is one on the wall in the Med room.
- 3) Cards will be collected from the mailboxes on ordering day.
- 4) The cards tell the person ordering exactly what to order.

5) Once supplies are received, bins will be refilled to the correct level and the Velcro Kanban card will be reattached to the bin or

foam board.







Error Proofing

- Timeless Medical breast milk tracking system uses unique barcode identifiers to ensure a correct match for every feeding and that the feeding unit has not expired.
- The system is able to track and trace expressed breast milk, donor human milk, and additives.



Feeding Process

1) Print bottle labels for mother

6) Bottle is delivered to bedside nurse

7) Bottle is scanned and then fed to the baby

2) Mother pumps into labeled bottles

5) Bottle is prepared based on physicians orders

3) Milk Tech receives bottles

4) Bottles are stored
