
Step 1- Loosen the cabinet outside screws and remove the stock deck.



Step 2- Remove the track hall and dust cover.




Step 3- Review stock deck wire color locations (Deck is pre-mapped to help with this step) polarity does not matter on the switches either side could be connected.



Step 4- Remove wires carefully prying them from the stock buttons (needle nose pliers help)




Step 5- Remove all button wires and move out of the way.



Step 6- Remove the screws from the headphone jack surround



Step 7- Lightly pry up the headphone jack surround with a small flat head screwdriver




Step 8- Remove headphone jack surround



The remaining steps are much easier by laying the deck on your knees in your lap.




Step 10- Leave joystick loose in holw with you rem











Step 16- Reinstall all items follow the steps in reverse on your new Mod1Up deck.

















Final Steps- The J Panels are marked Left (L) and Right (R) and must be installed as such.
