
Start - 1 - 2 - Finish




Start -1-2-1 - Finish



PORTABLE MARK ADDENDUM

When courses 1-7 are signaled, the Portable Mark Course addendum will apply.

Course rounding will be signaled by a "P" for Port or "S" for Starboard below the Class placard and number of course to be sailed by that Class.

A gate may be employed on any windward-leeward course. When there is a gate, boats shall sail between the gate marks from the direction of the previous mark and round either gate mark. Use of a gate will be signaled by display of a placard "G" following the course rounding signal.

Rule 12.3 (ALL BOATS MUST SAIL ON THE NORTHEAST SIDE OF INFLATABLE MARK "K") is still in effect.
