# **Notice of Race**

## 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

1.1. Hobie Fleet 65 will be the organizing authority.

## 2. RULES

- 2.1. Racing shall be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules of the International Hobie Class Association.
- 2.2. Competitors are reminded that per IHCA class rule 26, at least one crew member per boat shall be a paid member of the Hobie Class Association.
- 2.3. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 2.4. Any change in sailing instructions will be posted at least one hour prior to scheduled warning signal on official SAYC notice board and online at <a href="https://theclubspot.com/regatta/OPx9xZdqTb">https://theclubspot.com/regatta/OPx9xZdqTb</a>

# 3. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, AND ACCOUNTABLITY

3.1. This event is open to all class legal Hobie Wave's. Hobie 14's, Hobie 16's, Hobie 17's, Hobie 18's, and Hobie 20's

## 4. FEES

- 4.1. Regatta fees are as follows:
  - Double handed: \$50
  - Single handed: \$40
  - Youth: free (Youth are defined as all crew under the age of 21 years as of December 31 of the year the event begins.)
- 4.2. HCANA membership required for points.

# 5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Friday
  - Camping and setup is welcomed
- 5.2. Saturday
  - Registration 8:30 to 9:30 AM
  - Competitors meeting at 10:00 AM
  - First Warning Signal 11:00 AM

#### 5.3. Sunday

- Competitors meeting 9:30 AM (if needed)
- First Warning Signal 10:00 AM
- No races to start after 2:00 PM
- 5.4. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 5.5. When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When more than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 5.6. The objective is 3-5 races per day. There is no maximum number of races scheduled.

# 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board and available on site.

7.1. Shore Acres Yacht Club - 780 Drum Point Road, Brick, NJ 08723

#### 8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

8.1. Competitors may bring and use VHF radios. Their use and restrictions shall be described in the Sailing Instructions.

## 9. PRIZES

9.1. Prizes will be given for 3 places in all classes. Prizes may be given for additional places depending on the class registration.

## 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 11. LIABLITY

11.1. Each participating boat shall have current third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of not less than \$100,000 USD. Proof of insurance may be required at registration.
