

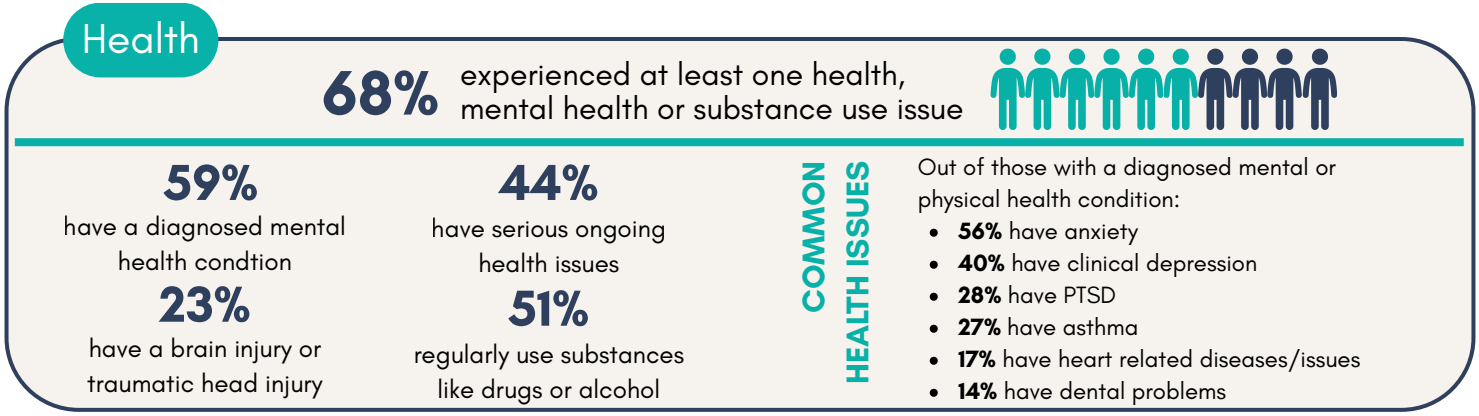
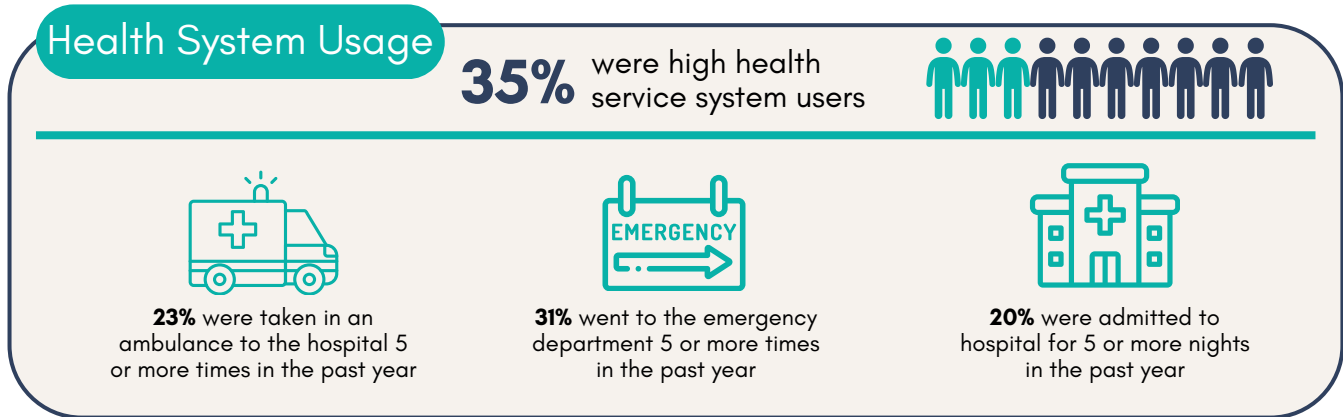
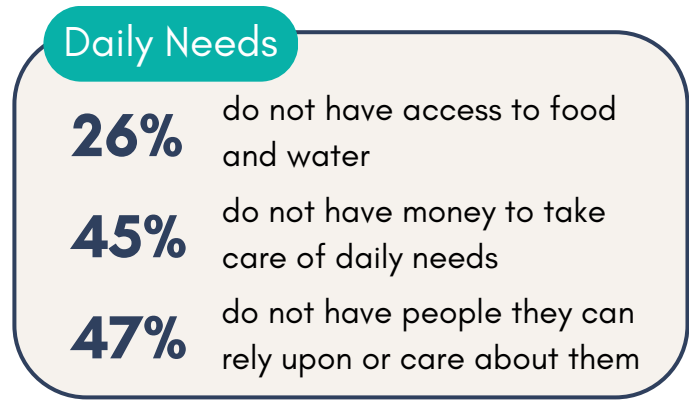
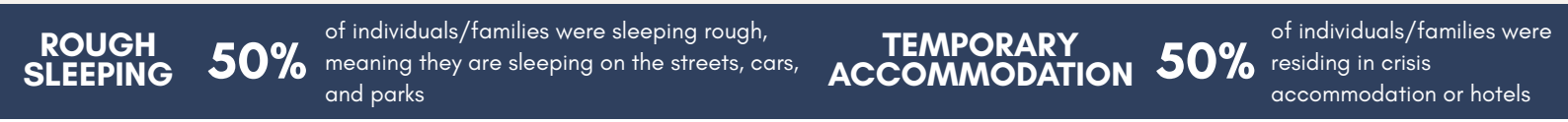
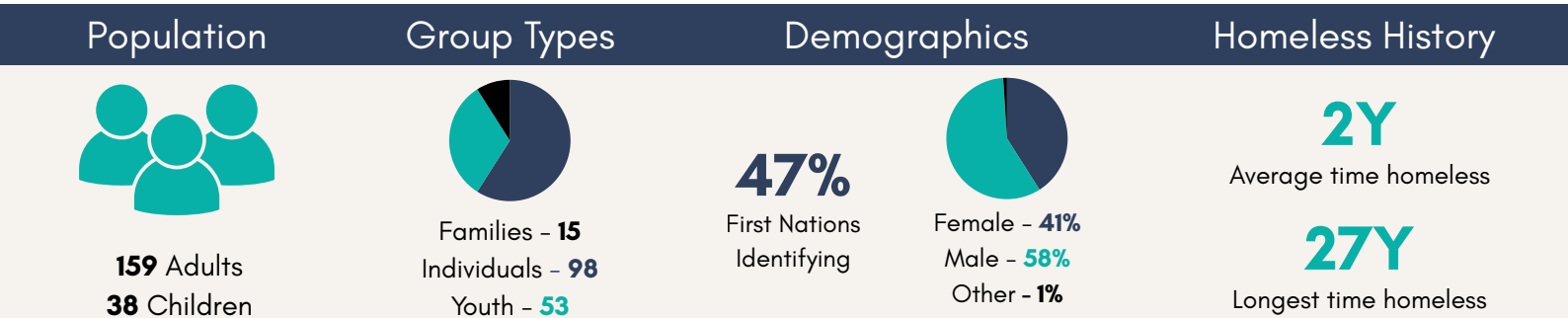
CENTRAL QUEENSLAND HOMELESSNESS VULNERABILITY SNAPSHOT

CQ Zero is a data driven, coordinated response to ending homelessness within Central Queensland.

CQ Zero has been in operation since December 2024 and since then has identified over 190 individuals experiencing homelessness within the region.

The data collected provides valuable information on people's needs, assists in triaging the most vulnerable, and helps advocate for systems change.
