

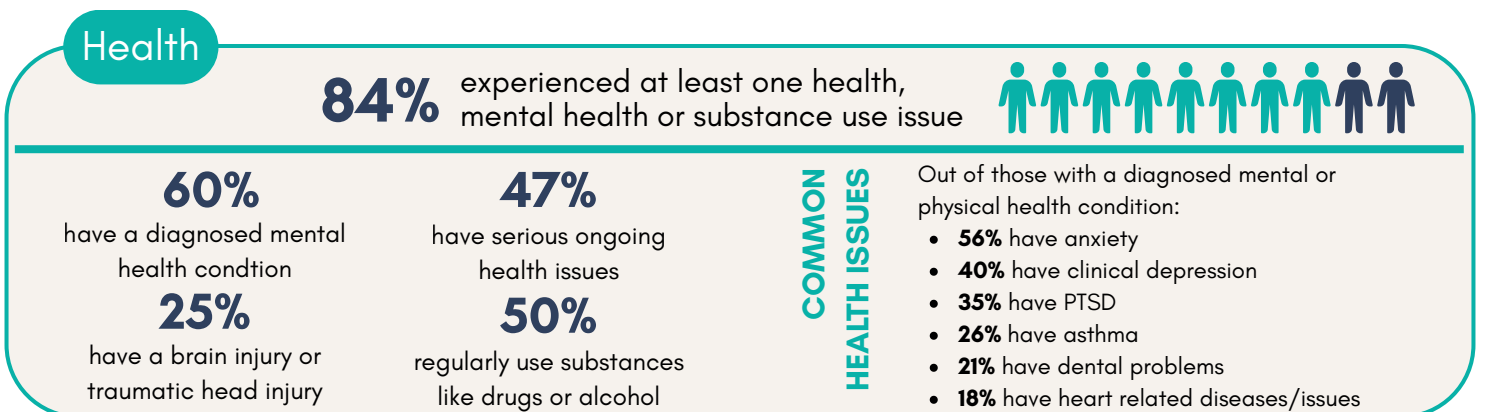
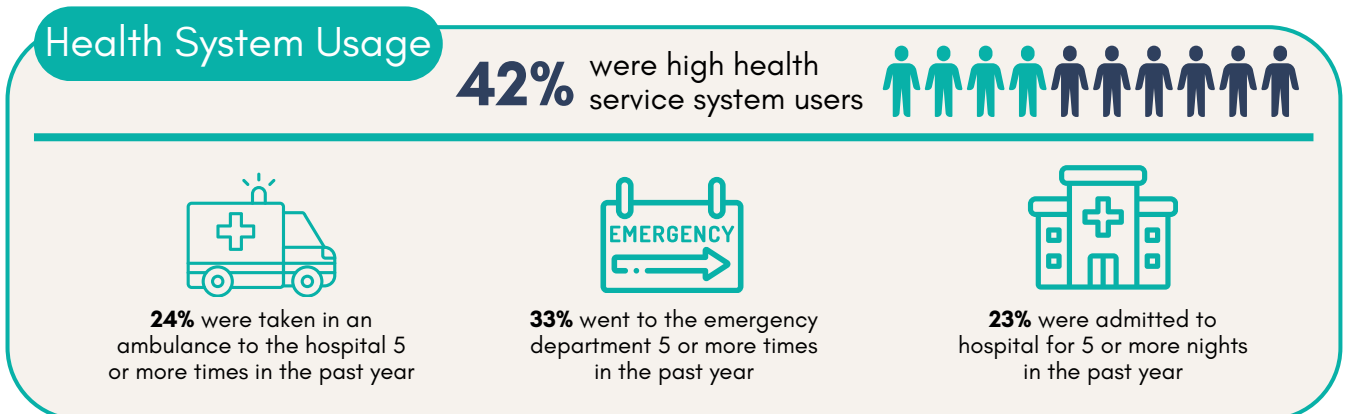
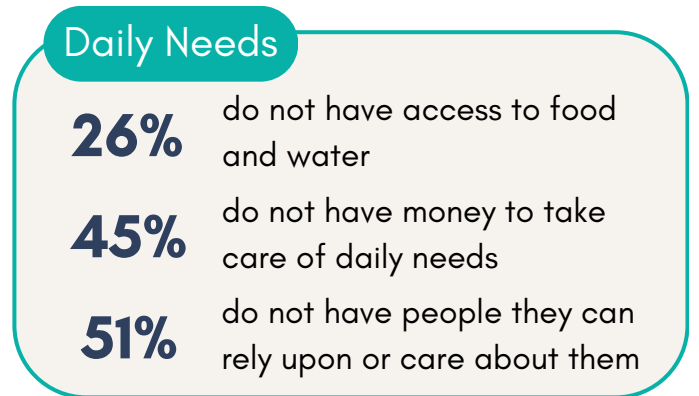
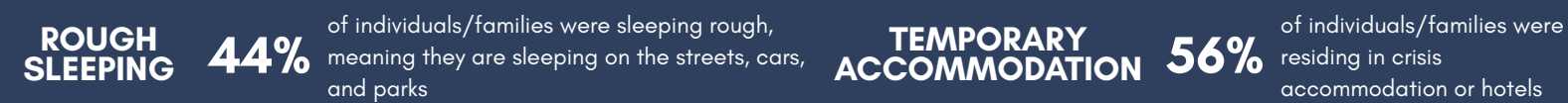
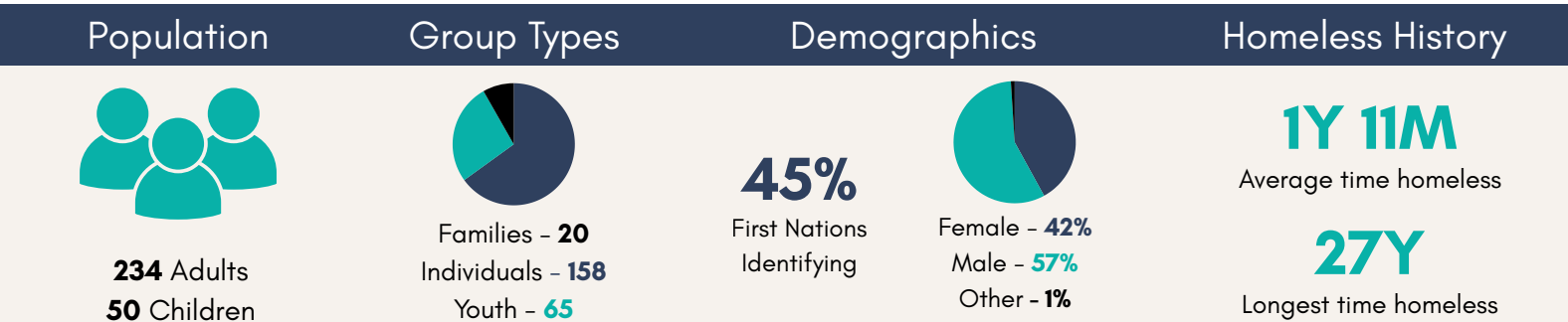
CENTRAL QUEENSLAND HOMELESSNESS VULNERABILITY SNAPSHOT

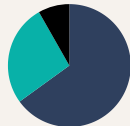
