

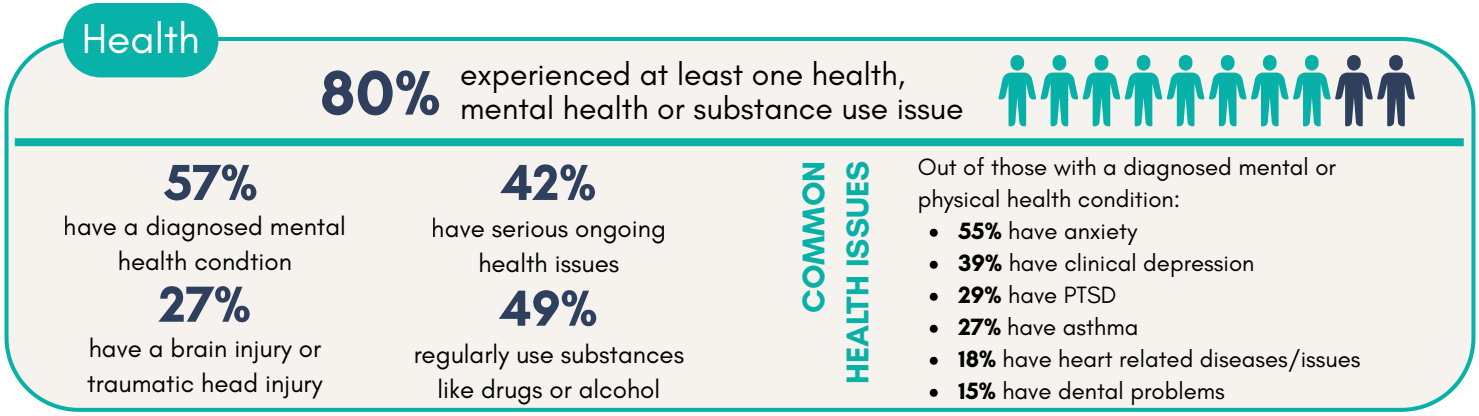
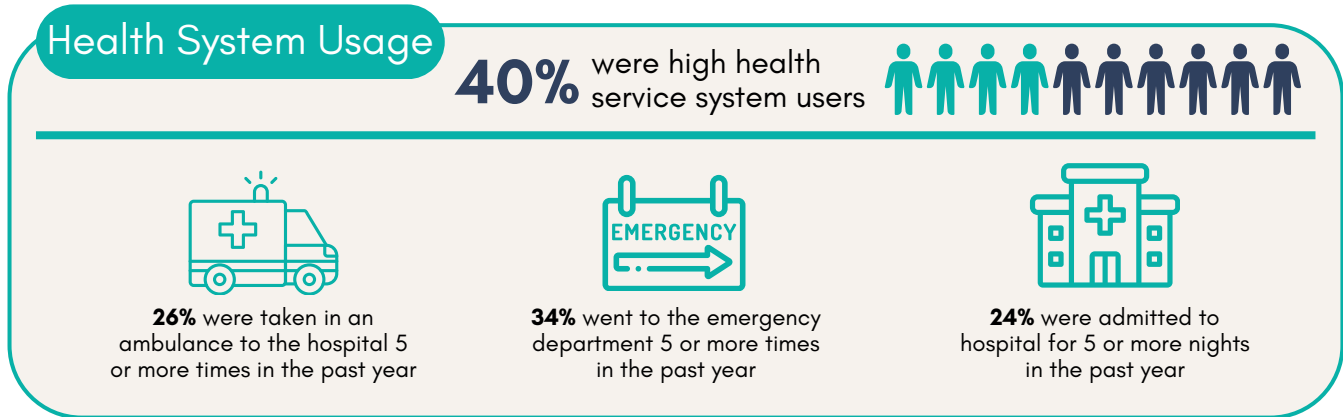
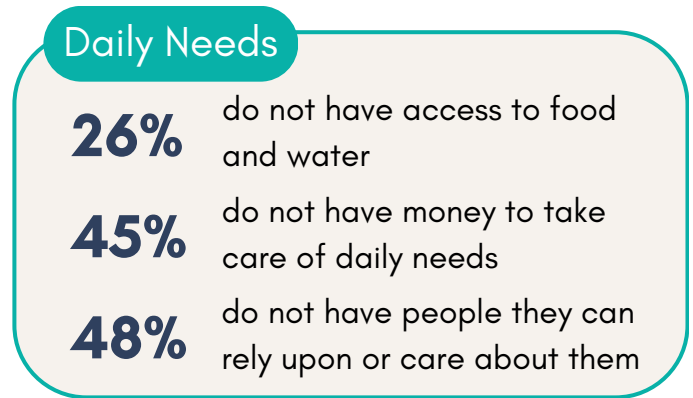
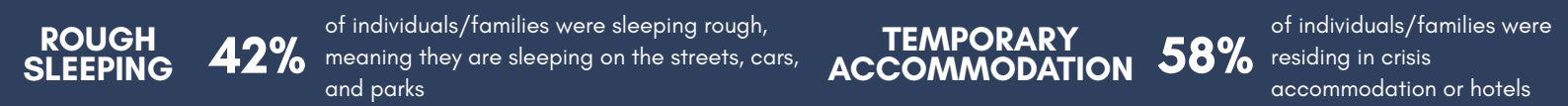
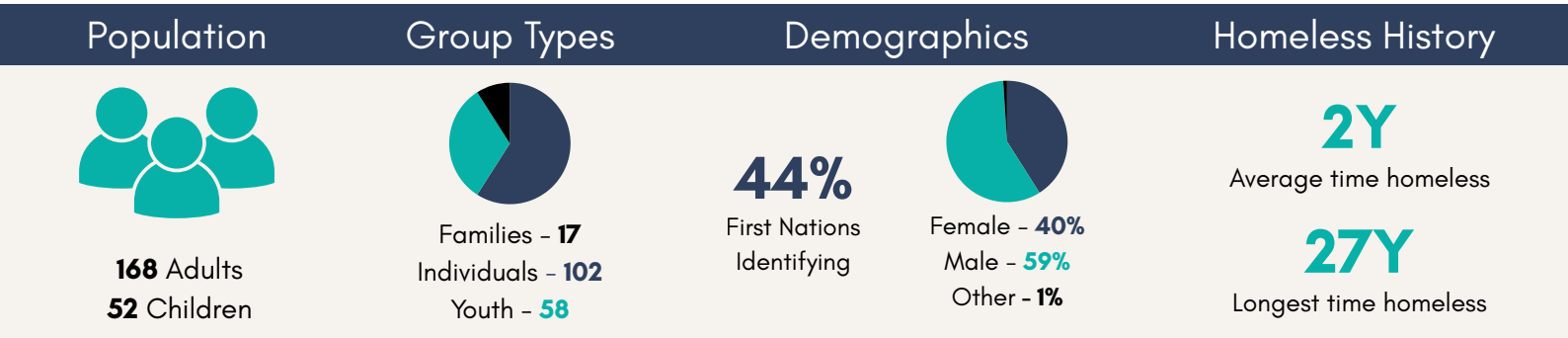
CENTRAL QUEENSLAND HOMELESSNESS VULNERABILITY SNAPSHOT

CQ Zero has been in operation since December 2024 and since then has identified over 200 individuals experiencing homelessness within the region.

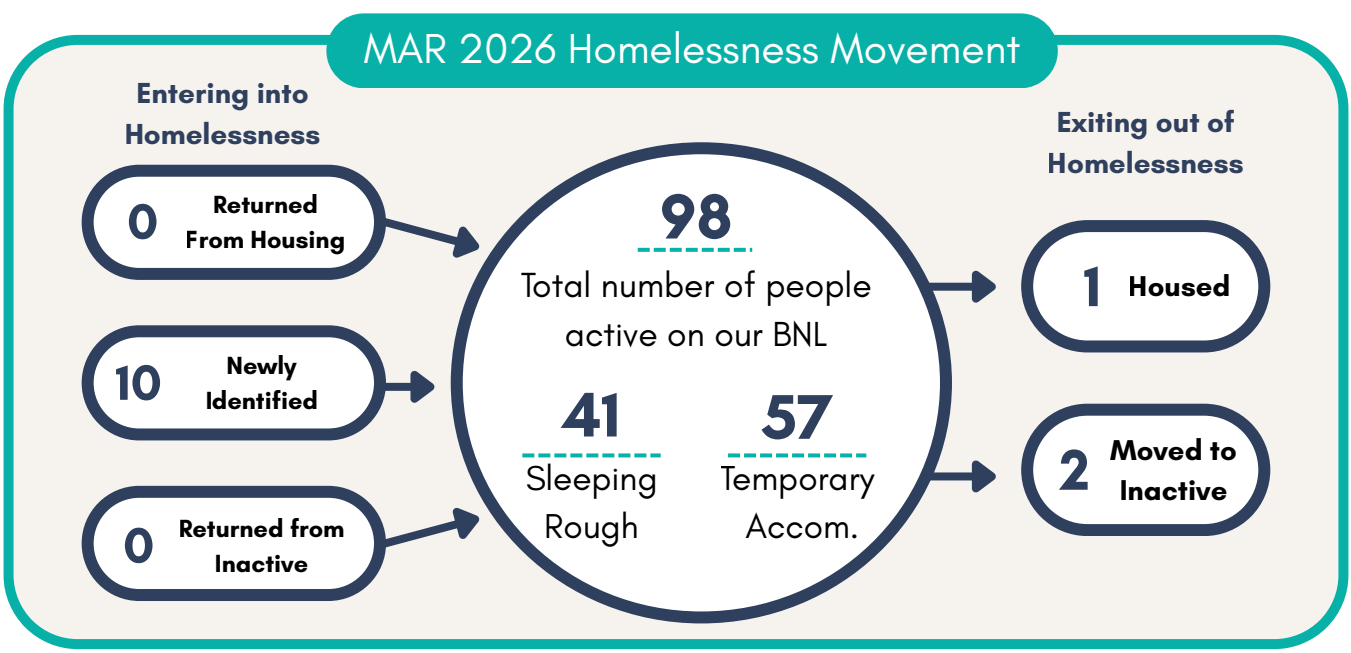
The data collected provides valuable information on people's needs, assists in triaging the most vulnerable, and helps advocate for systems change.

Additional Data

- 37%** do not seek medical help when unwell
- 43%** faced discrimination when trying to access services
- 34%** do not have access to a shower when they need it
- 48%** have never had a tenancy or house in their own name
- 29%** have lived in foster care and/or out of home care
- 77%** have a moderate complexity support need
