Your Moodboard - The Detail

Let's dive into the mood board in a little more detail! Sofa & armchair - I've included a beautiful pale mustard corner sofa and a soft pink armchair.

I would suggest keeping your vintage chest for the tv unit and styling a side table in the window along with the armchair.

You could potentially move the side table and lamp on the wall next to the fireplace over to the window. I'd recommend keeping this wall clear to make room for the new larger sofa.



A wooden lamp will look a lot softer than your current black one!

A grey column radiator will work perfectly against the paint work.

Soft furnishings using blue/pink tones which will compliment the yellow.

Above The TV



Option 1
Gallery wall using a mix of smaller prints in different style frames.



Option 2
A few floating shelves. These can be styled using books, decorative items or smaller leaning prints



Record Alcove Storage



Option 1
Remove the floating shelves and replace the current record storage with this standing shelving unit. This should house your record player, records & books!

Option 2
Add in some more
floating shelves, it looks
like there would be room
for 2 more!
Replace the current
record storage with this.
