

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

The standing seam roof work began on 5/8/24. The cement board and lap siding on the north elevation of the parent house is completed. The south elevation is being worked on. A step-up transformer needs to be installed to power up the HVAC equipment and elevators in the parent house. A step-up transformer will also be installed in the parking garage for the elevators, storage room HVAC and fire pump. The bathrooms on the first floor are tiled. The Kanemail for the parking garage exterior arrived on site on 5/9/24. A pre-installation meeting was held that afternoon. The courtyard concrete will be poured on 5/10/24. Substantial completion of the project is now scheduled for 9/2/24.


