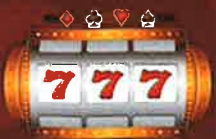

National Cleft and Craniofacial Awareness and Prevention Month

Nine-year-old patient Chloe



When not filming her story in a national Shriners Children's commercial, Chloe enjoys riding her pony, playing with her dogs, and practicing her secret talent of turning cartwheels. If Chloe picks the menu it is lasagna, starburst, sour patch kids and maybe strawberry with coconut flavored ice cream. Chloe's superpower would be the power to freeze things. Chloe has been coming to Shriners Cleft Lip and Palate clinic for a number of years for hard palate repair and bone grafting. The coming years mean more procedures for Chloe, but she uses her appointment time wisely, teaching most of the staff how to play her favorite game — "The Floor is Lava."

July was National Cleft and Craniofacial Awareness and Prevention Month

A cleft lip occurs when the lip does not properly form as the fetus develops in the womb. A newborn's smile with a cleft (split or divided) lip will have an opening in their upper lip that may extend into their nose. In some cases, the lip and the gum line may both have a cleft. Cleft lip may affect one side of the lip or both sides.



Many babies born with cleft lip also have an opening in the roof of their mouth called a cleft palate. Cleft lip, with or without cleft palate, occurs in about one in 1,000 babies and it's much more common in boys than girls.

Shriners Children's is an internationally recognized leader in treating cleft lip, cleft palate, and other craniofacial anomalies. Facial clefts are the number one craniofacial birth defect addressed by our patient and family-centered teams, led by our board-certified plastic surgeons. Cleft lip and palate in this country runs about one in 6 to 700 live births. It's usually a random occurrence. Shriners Children's pediatric surgeons and specialists focus exclusively on children and understand how growth and development impact the outcomes for a child's appearance and function.

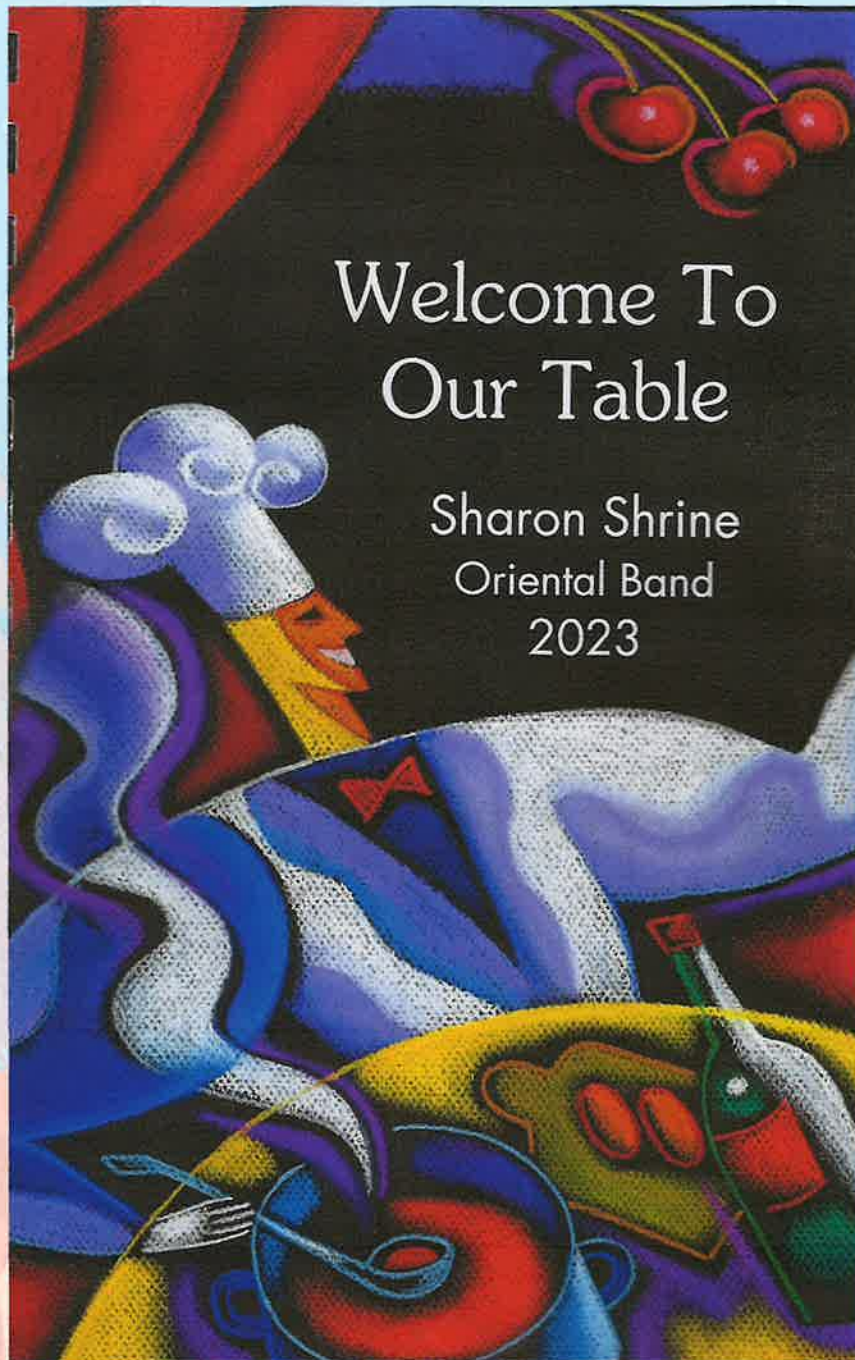
Like helping families?

How to Download and Use My FezCard Viewer

Download My FezCard Viewer – iPhone

1. Open the App Store on your phone.
2. Search for "My FezCard Viewer" and click on the icon.
3. Click the "Install" button to install My FezCard Viewer.

Using My FezCard Viewer

1. Open My FezCard Viewer. Enter your Shrine ID and Last Name. Type your Temple Name and click on it to highlight it as below. Click the "REGISTER" button at the bottom. You will only need to register the first time you open the app.



2. At the bottom of the screen, you will have two options: Shrine Card and QR Code. The screenshot below shows the Shrine Card option.



3. You can click "QR Code" at the bottom or swipe the screen to the left to view the QR Code for easy scanning at Temple events and functions.



Download My FezCard Viewer – Android
