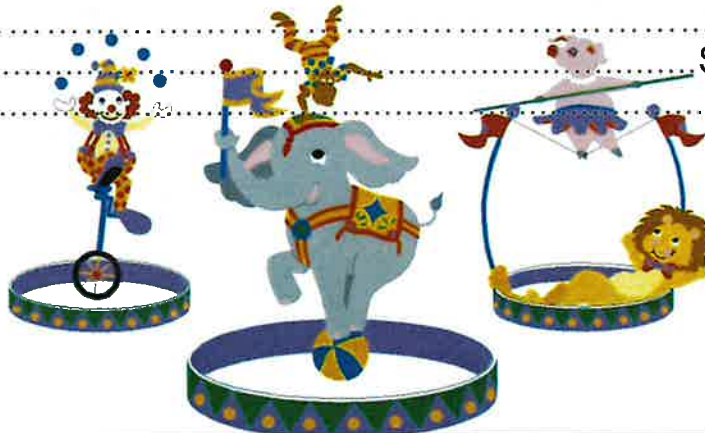

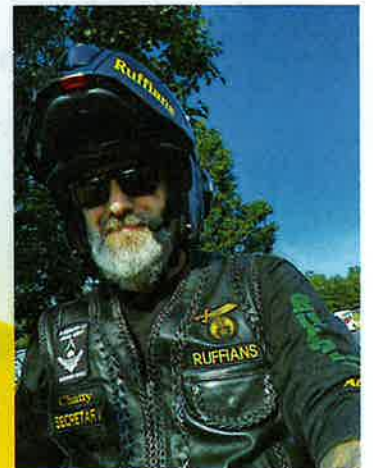

Always fun to go to TSA, but **ALSO, HAPPY** to get home.

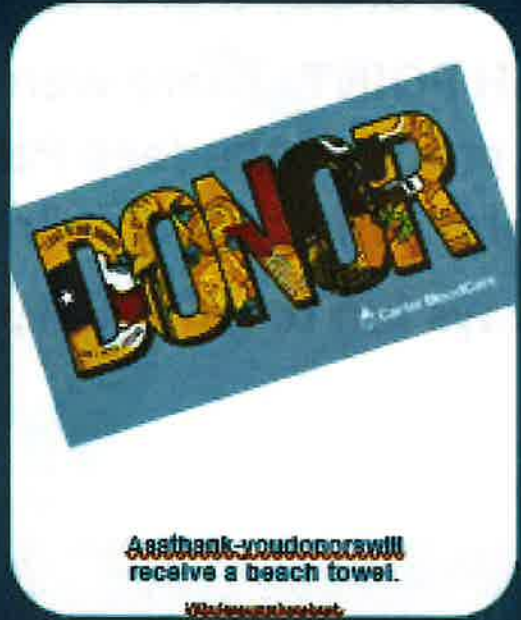
