As of now, the circus is expected to return to the East Texas area in February. This presents both unique opportunities and challenges. When we were made aware that the Oil Palace was being foreclosed on, we had to scramble to find

an alternative venue. Unfortunately, venues in the Tyler area were not available, so the circus owners had to make the difficult decision to postpone the event.

Looking ahead, there are plans for a new rodeo arena at the East Texas State Fairgrounds, and the circus owners hope to host the event there in the future. The challenge for us is that the postponement creates a \$60,000 to \$70,000 shortfall in next year's budget. If you have any ideas for fundraisers, please speak with the office or any member of the Divan. We need all hands on deck from our nobility to help with participation.

The Rose Parade is coming up, and each unit should have received the parade form. If you haven't, please contact Jason Brooks.

Speaking of contacting the office, our phone and internet system has been down more than it's been up over the past month. We've since changed phone providers and have been in constant contact with Optimum (our internet provider) to prevent this from happening again—though no promises there from the ISP.

Good luck to all the hunters—dove season began on September 1st, and whitetail season opens very soon.

THE VIEW FROM BEHIND THE GLASS

By now, I suppose everyone has heard about the circus "train wreck" caused by the unavailability of the Oil Palace for this year's Tyler Circus. The loss of this venue has resulted in a delay of all our circuses - except for Palestine - until February of 2026.

As the circus is our largest fundraising event, this represents a significant loss of revenue for the year. It seems unlikely that make-up circuses held in mid-winter will generate as much income as our traditional Labor Day events.

What you may not know is that the Smith County Appraisal District is attempting to charge us property taxes for the years 2023 and 2024 due to an exemption issue. Fortunately, the matter has been resolved for the 2025 tax year. We are contesting the ruling, but the ultimate outcome remains uncertain.

The net result of these unforeseen circumstances is that our revenue is likely to fall well short of expectations, while expenses are likely to increase.

Accordingly, your Divan is exploring other fundraising options. In the meantime, however, it occurs to me that my wife, Karen, and I are able to contribute more to the Shrine - an institution that has become an important part of our lives - than is represented by my annual dues. Therefore, I intend to contribute \$500 to the Shrine in September and to make further contributions as we are able.

I know there are other dedicated Shriners who may also be in a position to make contributions of their own. I encourage everyone to consider giving whatever they can afford - no amount is too small.

As a small token of recognition, it was suggested to add a contributions page to the monthly Script, listing all contributions for the month as well as cumulative totals.

Please understand, this is not meant to pressure anyone. It is simply a humble request for a little help from those who are able to lend a hand to Sharon Shrine.


