

Oriental Guide Candidate BIOGRAPHY OF CRAIG T. HUGHES September 8, 2022

The career of Craig Hughes has spanned over 40 years in a wide variety of industries, but his concentration has always been focused on inventory control, logistics management, and related information technologies. In later years he has expanded his scope into the direct management of the manufacturing process. His wife of 45 years is an attorney in Tyler, TX where they currently reside. He has two sons, one is the senior director for Fox in Washington D.C, and the other has earned a master's degree in Geophysics from LSU. He is currently employed by the state of Texas. Away from the office, Mr. Hughes is an instrument rated pilot, Ham Radio Operator, Scuba Diver, and a big game hunter.

After graduating from Stephen F. Austin State University in 1975, Mr. Hughes initially worked for Anderson Clayton Foods in production planning. It was at this time that he became involved with the American Production and Inventory Control Society (APICS) and became certified in production and inventory control. From Anderson Clayton he moved on to Mitsubishi Aircraft International where the new MU-300 business jet (now sold as the Beach Jet) was under development. Here he was instrumental in the installation of the IBM COPICS manufacturing system. Once again changing industries, Mr. Hughes moved to the fledgling MCI Communications Company. After initially being based in Washington, D.C., he moved on to Dallas, Texas where the MCI Engineering headquarters had been established. At the Dallas engineering facility, he and an APICS associate established an inventory management department for the first time. At the time, MCI was involved in the construction of billions of dollars' worth of microwave and fiber optic infrastructure. To manage this, Mr. Hughes helped develop the proprietary Engineering Planning System based on MRP methodology. After this he was promoted to the manager of the Logistics Management IT organization, and along the way, he was named as the primary inventor on an early U.S. patent for RF barcode scanning technology. In 1999 he was recruited to Hood Packaging Company in Tyler, TX as the Materials Manager. Wanting to get back to his East Texas roots, he took this position which soon expanded to the management of manufacturing operations as well as logistics. As Operations Manager he was responsible for Purchasing, Customer Service, Logistics Management, and all Manufacturing Departments (a total of more than 100 employees). He retired from this position in 2018, although he continues to do consulting for Hood Packaging.
