Reflections

The new year promises new opportunities to serve God and to extend the influence of His Kingdom. The Association's purpose is to **Encourage Fellowship** among our churches to **Exhort to the unity of Faith and Practice, Engage in missions and ministries, Equip through resources and training, and Exalt the Lord Jesus in all that we do.** The following are some of the things happening to fulfill that purpose statement.

Engaging in missions and ministries is moving forward. The Association is consolidating our mission endeavors around the world and **focusing on supporting churches and caring for our 45 girls.** Those who are currently supporting David and Thang please continue as they need your support. The mission to the children will be a long term commitment for our Association. We have established a separate entity to do this work, Grow International Ministries. We have trusted partners who facilitate our work with 307 churches and the work with the children.

Our Mexico mission continues. Mike and Laura Perry (Pastor and wife 1st Baptist Indianola), Justice Collier (Youth Director, 1st Baptist Indianola), and myself went to **Industrial, Chihuahua, Mexico** where there is a new church plant we have been supporting. We helped the River Valley Baptist churches of Mexico that we have partnered with for 24 years with Christmas celebrations. We also donated 1000.00 for the construction of the church building there. We will be planning a mission trip sometime in 2026 to go back and help with that building..

One of the great ministries that we have is **Kiamichi Baptist Assembly.** This year we have been a part of a fund raising campaign to try and enclose the Tabernacle so that it can be heated and cooled. This will also include new media systems and chairs. We have yet to sell the PBA large cabin but we are going to see what we can do to upgrade the old Dow cabin for use by our churches who do not have a cabin and want to go to KBA.

For 300 years, here in America, the Baptist Association has been helping to advance the work of the Kingdom of God. The Pittsburg Baptist Association has been at it for 115 years. Every church is important to what we do. I want to challenge the pastors and churches of our Association to become more involved in our work in the coming year. We have forty churches and seldom have even ten of them been represented at any one event. We can do better.

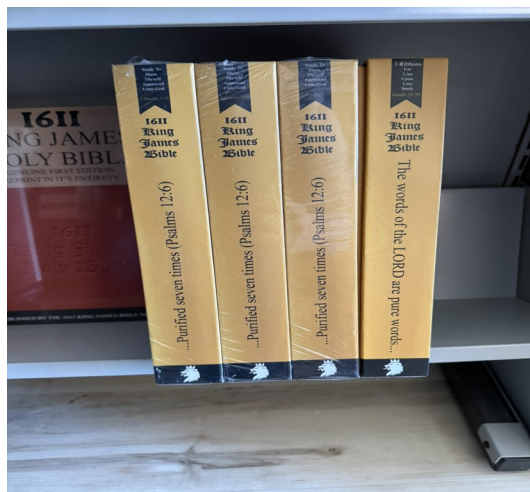
