UNION PLUS SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility

1. Union Member (Active or Retired), Spouse & Dependant Children
2. 1 year continuous good standing by May 31, 2022.
3. Attend a college, university, tech or trade school. Under Graduate or Graduate Classes
4. Must use in the fall 2022. May reapply each year.
5. Apply Online at www.unionplus.org
Hover on the drop down "Benefits & Discounts", on the left hover over "Education" then click on "Union Plus Scholarships", then click on "APPLY NOW". Follow prompts to create account or login and fill out application

IBEW FOUNDERS SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility

3. At least 4 years of continuous good standing
4. Attend a college or university, studying for a bachelor degree in some field that will further the electrical industry

IBEW® FOUNDERS' SCHOLARSHIP

The IBEW Founders' Scholarship honors the dedicated wiremen and linemen who, on November 28, 1891, organized the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers. Each year the officers of the IBEW are pleased to offer its working members scholarships on a competitive basis. It is hoped that the awards will not only contribute to the personal development of our members but also steward the electrical industry that our founders envisioned.

This award is for up to \$200 per semester credit hour or \$134 per trimester credit hour at any accredited college or university toward an associate's, bachelor's, or postgraduate degree in a field that will further the electrical industry overall (as determined by the Founders' Scholarship Administrator). The maximum distribution is \$24,000 per person over a period not to exceed 8 years.

RULES FOR ENTRY

The Founders' Scholarship competition is an adult program, to be used solely by IBEW members. It is NOT for the children of members.

1. Applicants must have been in continuous good standing and have paid dues without an honorary withdrawal for 4 years preceding May 1 of the scholarship year, or be charter members of a local union.
2. Each applicant must be recommended in writing by the local union business manager. If there is no business manager, then the recommendation must come from the local union president, system council chairman, or general chairman.
3. At least two additional letters of recommendation must be sent by individuals who are familiar with the applicant's achievements and abilities.
4. Copies of all academic transcripts from high school, college, apprenticeship, or other educational and developmental programs must be submitted.
5. A complete résumé is required. The résumé should outline the applicant's education and work history; military service; special honors or awards; and involvement in union, civic, community, or religious affairs.
6. Applicants are required to submit a 250-500 word essay (typed and double spaced). The title and topic must be: "How I Will Use My Founders' Scholarship to Benefit the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers and the Electrical Industry."
7. Materials need not be sent at the same time but all must be postmarked or emailed prior to May 1 of the scholarship year.

Selection of Winners

Awards will be based on academic achievement and potential, character, leadership, social awareness, and career goals.

The Independent Founders' Scholarship Selection Committee will be composed of academic, professional, and community representatives. They will examine the complete record of each scholarship applicant to choose the winners. All applicants will be notified, and the scholarship winners will be featured in *The Electrical Worker*.

Responsibility of Each Founders' Scholar

Scholarship winners must begin their studies in the term immediately following receipt of the award or in January of the following year. Each term's earned grades must be sent to the Founders' Scholarship Administrator together with a Founders' Scholarship Progress Sheet. After the first calendar year in the program, and by each August 1 thereafter, the annual Founders' Scholar paper is due. The paper must be at least 1,000 words on a labor-related topic, covering any aspect affecting the current labor movement or labor history. Scholarships are not transferable and are forfeited if the student withdraws or fails to meet the requirements for graduation from the school. If a serious life situation arises to prevent continuation of studies, the scholarship winner may request that the scholarship be held in abeyance for a maximum of 1 academic year.

Ten (10) \$500.00 Scholarships awarded annually, two from each Vice-Presidential District, if possible and administered by The Texas State Association of Electrical Workers.

Who May Apply: Members or children of members of Local Unions of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers which are affiliated with the Texas State Association of Electrical Workers. Applicants must be High School Seniors who are planning to attend a university, college, or technical institute in the summer or fall term. The grants will be paid directly to the school upon acceptance.

Local Unions will be notified and furnished application material in December of each year. The deadline for applying is January 31 of each year. To ensure proper processing, please be sure to list the IBEW Local Union you or your parent(s) are members of, **make sure the application is signed by a Local Union Officer**, and include your latest high school transcript.

Applications may also be obtained from the Texas State Association of Electrical Workers, P.O. Box 22592 Beaumont, Texas 77720.

A package will be sent to each applicant upon receipt of a completed application form. **The qualifying materials contained in this package must be returned to The Texas State Association of Electrical Workers and must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2022.** The returned material will be evaluated and graded during March and April and a winner selected. The winners will be notified in May.

2022 TEXAS AFL-CIO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

WHO MAY APPLY: Members or children of members of local unions or children whose legal guardians are members of local unions that are affiliated with the Texas AFL-CIO and the local Central Labor Council. *Applicants must be high school seniors who are planning to attend a university, college or technical institute in the summer or fall term. Scholarships are one-time grants of \$1,500.*

Application forms are available at www.texasaflcio.org/scholarship, from your Central Labor Council, or from the Texas AFL-CIO Education Department - P. O. Box 12727, Austin, Texas 78711. **THE POSTMARK DEADLINE FOR APPLYING IS MONDAY, JANUARY 31, 2022.**

TO INSURE PROPER PROCESSING: *Please be sure to list the Central Labor Council, if any, with which your parent's or legal guardian's local union is affiliated. Make sure the application is signed by a union officer and at least one parent or legal guardian. Include an official school transcript and if applicable, proof of legal guardianship. If you are unsure that your local union is affiliated with your local Central Labor Council, please contact one of your local union officers. **PLEASE MAIL APPLICATIONS TO: TEXAS AFL-CIO EDUCATION DEPARTMENT - P. O. BOX 12727, AUSTIN, TEXAS 78711. Incomplete applications will be returned to the student.***

A packet of material on organized labor will be sent to each applicant to prepare for a test about unions. If you do not receive your packet, please contact your central labor council, a local union officer, or the Texas AFL-CIO.

SELECTION PROCESS: Each Central Labor Council will arrange all interviews and tests for applicants no later than April 8, 2022. Please contact your Central Labor Council if you have not received notice of an interview by April 1, 2022. **YOU MUST BE TESTED AND INTERVIEWED IN THE CENTRAL LABOR COUNCIL DISTRICT IN WHICH YOUR LOCAL UNION IS AFFILIATED.**

After interviews and tests are conducted, each local Central Labor Council will select semi-finalists from among their applicants. Applicant's financial need, academic achievements, extra-curricular activities, and his/her understanding of the labor movement as demonstrated by the test scores and interviews will be considered.

The statewide Scholarship Committee of the Texas AFL-CIO will select winners from among the semi-finalists. The results will be mailed to all applicants. High Schools principals will receive notice of winning applicants whose name will be announced in the Texas AFL-CIO Labor News.

If you are awarded a scholarship, please contact the Texas AFL-CIO Education Department in writing or via email to ed@texasaflcio.org and give us the name and address of the university, college or technical institute you plan to attend. **The scholarship will be paid directly to the school of your choice upon acceptance.**
