
## **U9 Build-Out Line**



The build-out line promotes playing the ball out of the back, while creating more opportunities and improvement of a player's understanding of the game in a less pressured setting.

- 1. When the goalkeeper has possession of the ball.
- 2. Goal kicks.

Opposing team must drop back behind the Build Out Line until the ball is put into play by the keeper or the goal kick is taken. Once the ball is in play, the opposing team may advance to play the ball. An infraction of the Build Out Line is an indirect free kick from the Build Out Line. The keeper or goal kick may quickly try to advance the play of the ball, in which case the opposing team may play the ball without the need to retreat to the line.
