



Our most requested service, individual therapy, addresses concerns about self-image, values, distressing emotions, and problem behaviors.

FAMILY THERAPY

Typically initiated when a child has behavioral or emotional difficulties. It helps the family support the child.

MARITAL/COUPLES THERAPY


Focuses on relationship issues rather than individual mental health. It can be used alongside individual therapy for one or both partners if needed.





What is 988?

988 is the easy-to-remember number for the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline (formerly the National Suicide Prevention) Lifeline). Trained crisis counselors are available 24/7 nationwide to support anyone facing a mental health, substance use crisis, or emotional distress.







The number 800-273-8255 (TALK) will continu to function indefinitely. For life-threatening crises (e.g., a suicide attempt), call 911.


Studies show most 988 callers feel less depressed, suicidal, and overwhelmed, and more hopeful after speaking to a crisis counselor.

• Local Routing: Calls to 988 go to a local crisis center based on your area code, with a national backup if needed.

Support: Trained counselors assist and connect you with local resources

- Veterans: Press option 1 for specialized support for veterans, active military, and their families.
- Privacy: Counselors see your phone number or IP address but no other personal details. Providing personal info is optional.
- Languages: Text and chat are in English only. Phone services are in English and Spanish, with translation for 250 languages.
- Effectiveness: Over 98% of interactions are resolved without 911.
