

Changes coming to your household!

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is making a BIG CHANGE to the way Housing Authorities manage properties.

A new inspection process becomes effective July 1, 2023 that moves the inspection process from REAC to NSpire (National Standards for the Inspection of Real Estate). HUD will require Housing Authorities to closely monitor the conditions of the inside of all apartments.

So it really matters how you keep your home! HUD is looking at the physical condition of inside of the apartment. Please help us score well by 1) reporting any work orders, 2) keeping your home clean and 3) reporting any pest presence in your home. Please declutter your home because we will fail if hoarding conditions are present.

We're here to help! Let us know if you need any guidance in keeping your home clean, or if you have a disability, and need assistance, we can help set you up with a service agency.

Juneteenth 2023 is June 19th

Maintenance Notice: Reporting: Air Conditioning Units

Charges for A/C units began May 1st at \$25.00 each unit, each month through September.

Lease Highlights

1. Garbage, Trash, and Litter (Section C, 3. of your Resident Handbook):
You will need proper containers for the deposit of all garbage within your home. It must be properly disposed of as needed in the dumpsters that are provided by the Housing Authority. Car and bicycle parts are to be placed within the dumpster. You are responsible for the disposal of car and bicycle tires. You should be carefulwhile carrying trash to the dumpster. Don't leave any garbage lying on the ground.

2. Differences in Opinion (Section C, 5. of your Resident Handbook):

If you have a problem with the behavior of a neighbor, you should try to discuss it with them. Problems are best resolved by the participants alone. However, if a matter is left unresolved, it can grow into a larger problem. Housing Authority staff may become involved if it involves lease violations. If the matter represents a direct threat to the health or safety of someone in your family, the police should be contacted by dialing 911.
