How Do Animals Get Ready for Winter?

Crockpot Apple Crisp

Ingredients

- 2 cans (21oz each) apple pie filling
- ¼ cup caramel ice cream topping
- 1 box yellow cake mix
- ½ cup butter, melted
- EXTRA! Vanilla ice cream



Instrusctions

- Spray the inside of the crockpot with cooking spray
- Pour both cans of the apple pie filing in the bottom and spread evenly.
- Drizzle caramel sauce over the apples.
- Sprinkle dry cake mix evenly over the top. Do not mix!
- Drizzle melted butter evenly over the cake mix, cover as much of the cake mix as you can.
- Cook on high for 1.5 to 2 hours or low for 3 to 4 hours. Until the edges are golden and the top is set.
- Serve warm with a scoop of ice cream!
