QUEST PLUS





Same gel formulation as Quest - disperses well and dissolves in the horse's mouth. For the treatment of infections due to internal parasites, including tapeworms and bots in horses and ponies four months of age and older. Treats up to 600kg/tube. Store Between 15-30°C and do not freeze.

For use in horses, ponies, breeding mares, stallions and foals over 4 months of age for the treatment and control of large and small strongyles, roundworms, pinworms, hairworms, stomach worms, bots and encysted small strongyles. Store Between 15-30°C and do not freeze.

STRONGID-P





Strongid P is a potent equine dewormer containing pyrantel pamoate. It is approved for treatment of large and small strongyles, pinworms, ascarids and the common tapeworm in horses and foals over 8 weeks of age. Each syringe contains enough caramel flavored paste to treat 1200 lb body weight. Store Between 15-30°C and avoid direct sunlight. Do not freeze.
