

## **SAFETY BRIEFING**

- 1. SMAC safety officers present today are NAMES.
- 2. Today, we will fly LH (or RH) circuits using the N-S (or E-W) runway.
- 3. Height limit is 121.92 metres / 400 feet AGL.
- 4. Pilots must be MAAA members.
- 5. Pilots to stand on yellow markers on flight line.
- 6. Spectators not permitted in pits area or on flying field (unless accompanied by a SMAC member).
- 7. Aircraft to be started/armed/run using restraints provided inside and outside pits area.
- 8. Centre opening in pits fence is only for pilots and hand-carried (disarmed) electric aircraft.
- 9. All other aircraft to be moved to/from flying field via north and south fence openings.
- 10. No taxiing inside pits area aircraft must be restrained at all times while being moved in/out of the pits.
- 11. No taxiing behind or within 5m of pilots on flight line.
- 12. Maximum of 5 aircraft in the air at any one time.
- 13. No flying over the pits, car park or clubhouse.
- 14. Don't cut the North Eastern or South Eastern corners of the pit area keep 30m clear.
- 15. Do not fly too far south towards Langhorne Creek Road (when using N-S runway). 100m
- 16. No flying west of access road.
- 17. Pilots should talk to each other and call take off/landing/dead stick etc.
- 18. Dead sticks have priority.
- 19. Retrieving aircraft request others to stay clear or wait until no craft in the air.
- 20. Heavy models must have current permit to fly permit to be sighted before first flight.
- 21. Turbine-powered aircraft must have current permit to fly permit to be sighted before first flight.
- 22. Turbine-powered aircraft contact helicopter pilot prior to first turbine flight of day Peter McSherry 0407 779 669.
- 23. Fire safety cart to be on flying field near flight line.
- 24. For aerobatic, 3-D and turbine flights request dedicated use of flying field NAME(S).
- 25. Full size aircraft have priority several airfields nearby.
- 26. South Coast helicopter has priority land ASAP if helicopter spools up, takes off or comes in to land.
- 27. Aerobatic manoeuvres to be performed on the Eastern or Northern (if using E-W 'runway') leg of the circuit.
- 28. When using E-W 'runway', maintain 30m between flight line and aircraft path (same as N-S runway/flight line).
- 29. There is an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) in the club house.
